A 24-hour emergency shelter for runaway, homeless, exploited or otherwise displaced youth. Youth are provided a hot meal, clothing, crisis intervention, case management, counseling, and family reunification (when appropriate).

<u>Kings/Tulare County Warmline</u>: Anyone, any age, can call the non-crisis Kings/Tulare Warm Line available 24/7, including weekends and holidays. The Warm Line is a number you can call when you need to speak with someone who will listen to your concerns without judgment or criticism. It is a peer-to-peer telephone support service that is staffed by people who have experienced the same kinds of issues a caller might have. We are ready to listen when you are ready to talk. LOSS Team: The Local Outreach to Suicide Survivors, or L.O.S.S. Team, was developed by Dr. Frank Campbell of Baton Rouge, Louisiana and is comprised of volunteers who serve as a primary initial supports to local survivors of suicide loss (such as family members, friends, coworkers, etc. who have just lost someone to suicide). These teams typically function around-the-clock and respond to the scene of suspected suicide deaths once called in by the scene's first responder or hospital staff. Team members will interact with the family (known as loss survivors) and provide them with resources and support so that they do not have to feel alone as they seek to deal with the emotions that accompany loosing someone to suicide.
