

USD 252 COVID MITIGATION PLAN SCHOOL YEAR 2021-22

MASKS

Wearing a mask and/or face covering at school is highly recommended. Masking will be required in areas where social distancing of 3 feet or less cannot be maintained. Per federal requirements masks are required while using school transportation. We recommend you provide your own masks.

HYGIENE MEASURES

Hand sanitizer stations are available at entrances of each building. USD 252 staff and students will sanitize their workspaces and items. Hand sanitizer and/or hand washing stations are available in each classroom. Signage is posted throughout the buildings promoting hygiene efforts.

SOCIAL DISTANCING

USD 252 staff and students will social distance whenever possible. Spacing will be increased when possible during in-person instruction. Staff are encouraged to utilize outdoor space and large common areas when possible.

TESTING AND VACCINES

Free rapid testing is available to staff, families of staff, and students. Online forms must be submitted prior to testing. Drive-thru testing is available by appointment from 9:00 am - 10:00 am Monday - Friday at each attendance center. Vaccine clinics will be made available in conjunction with our local health department

INSTRUCTION AND REMOTE LEARNING

In-person instruction will continue to be the primary structure for the 2021-22 school year. With prior approval, remote instruction will be reserved for those students who have exceptional circumstances.

QUARANTINES AND EXCLUSIONS

USD 252 will work with the local health department and their guidelines for quarantine and exclusion in the case of a positive or close contact case.

EXTRA CURRICULARS

USD 252 will continue to follow the recommendations from KSHSAA with regard to extra curricular activities. Hand sanitizer, cleaning supplies, and other safety equipment will be made available to all players and coaches.
