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
What is Title I?

Wacona Elementary is identified as a Title I school as part of the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). Title I is designed to support State and local school reform efforts tied to challenging state academic standards by reinforcing and enhancing efforts to improve teaching and learning for students. Title I programs must be based on effective means of improving student achievement and include strategies to support family engagement. All Title I schools must jointly develop, with all parents, a written family engagement plan.

HOW is it revised?

Wacona Elementary School invited all parents to attend our annual Title I Evaluation and Input Meeting. The input meeting is held each spring to review and revise this parent and family engagement plan, as well as the school wide plan, our school-parent compact, and the family engagement budget. Additionally, parent responses regarding this plan are welcome during the school year, and the plan is posted on our school web site for parents to view. All parent feedback received during the year will be used to revise the plan for the next school year. We also distribute an annual survey online and hard copies (upon request) to ask parents for their suggestions on the plan and the use of the funds for family engagement. Parents and family members can also give feedback during several parent meetings and activities during the school year.

WHO is it for?

Wacona is a school-wide Title I School; therefore, all students participate in the Title I, Part A program. Students and families are encouraged and invited to fully



participate in the opportunities described in this plan. Wacona Elementary will provide full opportunity for the participation of parents with limited English, parents with disabilities and parents of migratory children.

WHERE is it available?

At the beginning of the year, the plan is sent home with all students. The plan will also be available on the school website. Additional hard copies of the plan will be available in the front office and Parent Resource Center.

Wacona will take the following measures to promote and support parents and family members as an important foundation of the school in order to strengthen the school and reach our school goals.

We will:

- ✓ Ensure that all information related to school and parent programs, meetings, and other activities is published in both English and Spanish, posted on the school website, and made available through other virtual/electronic methods.
