Frequently Asked Questions

Are masks going to be required?	Masks are required when indoors and on school busses.
Will there be a virtual option for students?	There will not be a virtual option. Students will be attending in person.
Will we require vaccines?	No
How will the district verify vaccines?	Parents will be asked to sign a consent form at registration. The Barneveld School district will hold the position that a student has not been vaccinated if permission to view the information on the registry is not granted or evidence is not provided by the parent/guardian/adult student that he/she has been vaccinated.
Are we still going to measure/watch close contact and the 15 minutes over the 24 hours?	If there is a confirmed case, grade level families will be notified and we will monitor for symptoms as well as provide follow-up testing.
How will my student receive instruction while he/she is isolated?	Teachers will be in continual communication with students and families, providing physical and digital materials. Students will have access to materials in Schoology or SeeSaw Teachers will work with students upon their return to make up missed content.
Who will you listen to, CDC, DHS, County Health?	CDC as a primary and in consultation with the local health department. They provide recommendations, but it is ultimately the decision of the local governing body.
Will Covid-19 testing be available at school?	Yes

How much does the test cost?	There is no cost for the testing
Who will be tested?	Students who are either symptomatic or who are identified as a close contact
What routines and procedures from last year will carry over?	 School day 8:10-3:15. Pick up/drop off will be in the front of the building. Nightly sanitizing Social distancing when able Sanitizing stations at entrances and throughout the building. Mask breaks throughout the day
Close Contact Protocols	We will follow Iowa County Health Department Guidelines (link) As long as masks are being properly worn, contact tracing, and quarantine will not be necessary. This will allow students to stay in school if there is a confirmed positive case within the classroom
Who will be notified if there is a confirmed case?	A notification will go out to the entire school that there is a confirmed positive case. Additional communications will go to students/families if the confirmed case was from your child's class.
How will co-curriculars be run?	Games will be open to the general public as well as live-streamed on our youtube channel. Face coverings are required for participants as well as spectators.
Will masks be required for co-curricular activities?	Yes, for indoor events.
Will you use a 7, 10, 14-day quarantine?	A student who tests negative after the 7th day of exposure will be allowed to return to school. If he or she is not tested, they would remain out for at least 10 days but no more than 14.
What will the transportation guidelines be?	All students will be required to wear face coverings while using school-provided transportation.
