# MJH Sports Boosters Uniform Rental (Effective with the start of the 23 - 24 school year; this is in addition to the \$50 sports fee by the district which goes towards refs, coaches, building use)

Fee: \$60 (reimbursable)

A uniform rental fee MUST be paid before each athlete receives a uniform. This is a separate fee from the Athletic Registration fee. Student athletes will NOT be allowed to participate in the sport (including practice) or receive a uniform until fees are paid to both MJH and MJH Sports Boosters, a current sports physical in on file, and all permission slips are turned in to the Athletic Director.

The \$60 Uniform Rental Fee will be fully reimbursed under all of the following conditions:

- 1. The uniform is returned to the Athletic Director no later than 1 week after the season's end.
- 2. The uniform is returned in acceptable, clean condition with no stains, marks, or holes.
- 3. A parent or guardian has volunteered for the required amount of shifts for the season's home games and tournaments. The amount of shifts will be determined by the number of participants and games per each sport season. This will be communicated at the Coach/Sports Boosters meeting prior to the start of the 1st practice.

Each shift missed/unfilled will result in a \$15 deduction from the \$60 reimbursable uniform rental. If ALL shifts are missed there will be NO reimbursement.

A ruined uniform will result in NO reimbursement.
