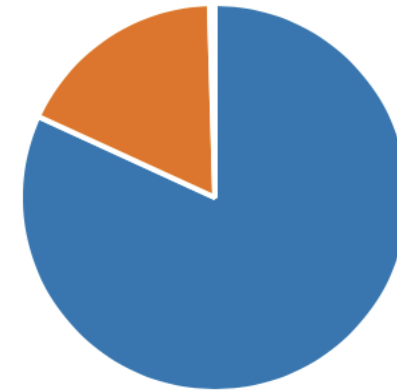

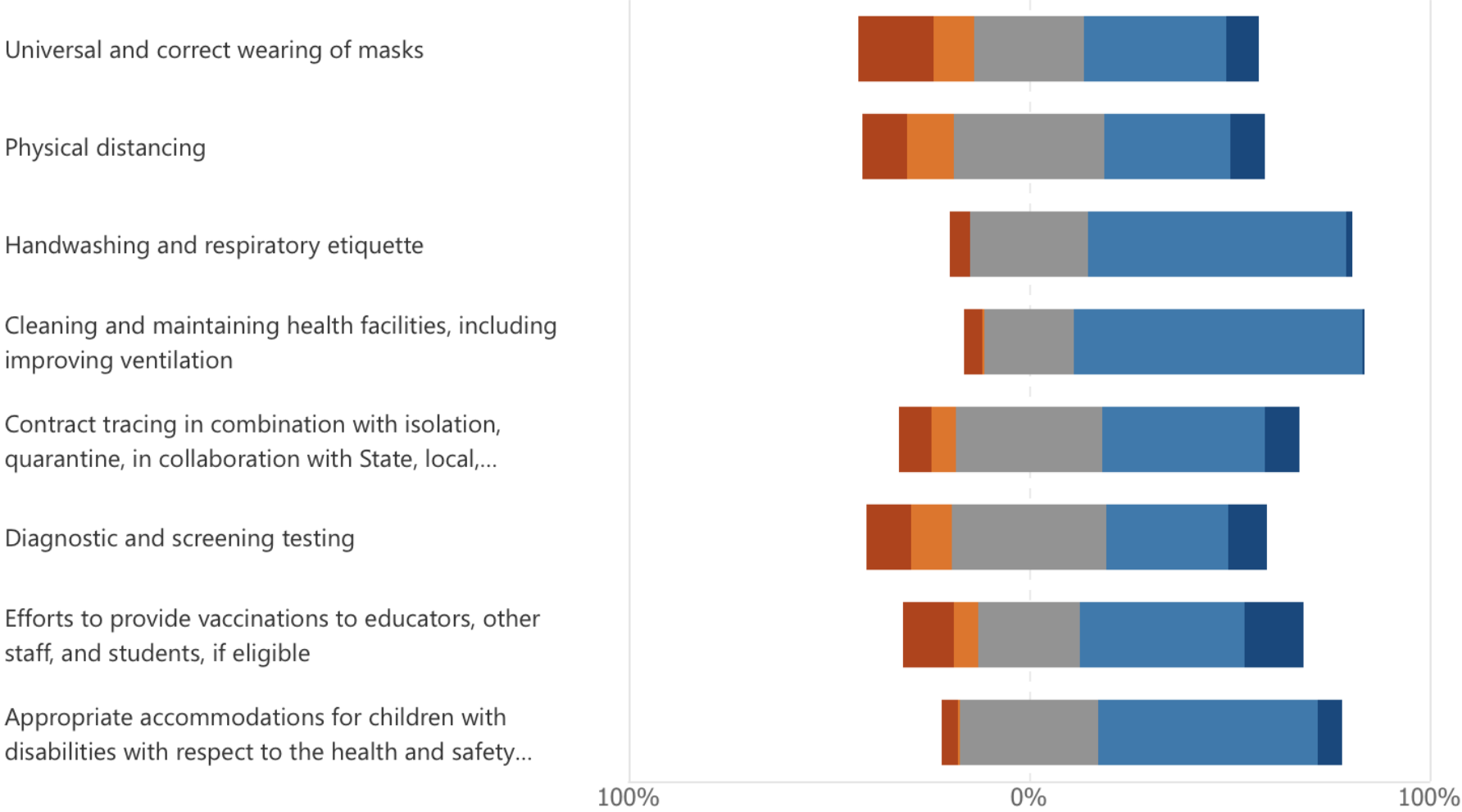

UNIVERSAL AND CORRECT WEARING OF MASKS, PHYSICAL DISTANCING AND CONTACT TRACING IN COMBINATION WITH ISOLATION AND QUARANTINE

- The district continues to follow the mandate from the Governor of New Jersey concerning the use of masks on school grounds as outlined in Executive Order # 251.
- The district shall adhere to New Jersey Department of Health guidance and/or Executive Order for social distancing in schools, contract tracing and quarantine procedures.
 - Schools will allow for social distancing within the classroom to the maximum extent practicable
 - The District will continue to review the use of all individual PPE (plexiglass, desk shields, etc) and apply those PPE supplies when and if social distancing cannot be implemented as outlined by NJDOH and/or Executive Order

PARENTS

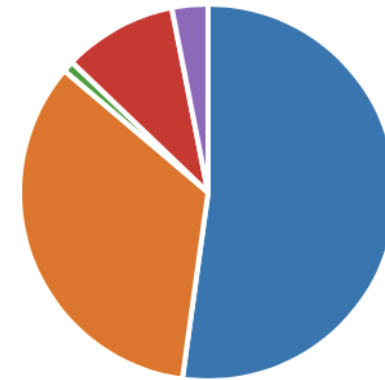
- Requesting no mask mandate

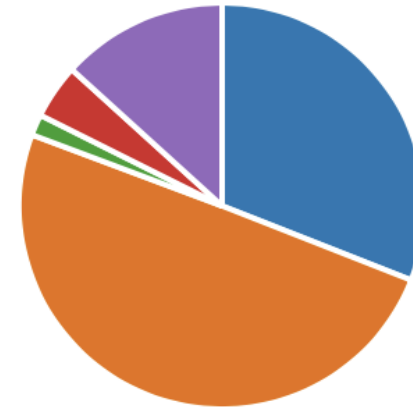
- Support mental health for students

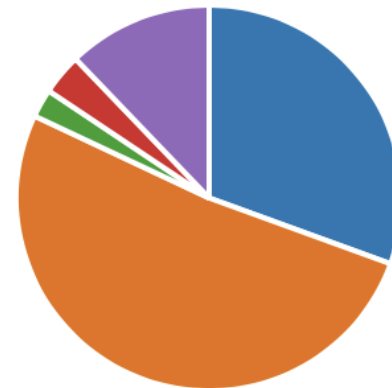
