

Board Committees

The Board authorizes the President to appoint such special committees as are deemed necessary. The functions of committees shall ordinarily be fact-finding, deliberative, and advisory, and their reports shall be made to the Board for discussion and action. The function of such committees may be legislative or administrative when so authorized by special action of the Board. The President of the Board and the Superintendent shall be ex-officio members of all such committees. Insofar as possible, announcement of committee meetings incorporated into the minutes for purposes of public announcement.

No individual member and no group comprised of less than full membership shall be designated as permanent committee to perform any of the Board's functions except those for which state law requires signatures.

Conduct of committee meetings will conform to the conduct of the Braxton County Board of Education meetings.
