*The Leadership Team and administration are completing final preparations for the Engagement Review Team's visit April 23rd-April 25th. The documentations needed have been uploaded to the eProve workspace, the slideshow presentation is being completed, and the schedule of the visit is being finalized.

*A training was held at the end of March, in Bismarck, on the Comprehensive Support grant that Warwick Elementary School was selected for. All schools in North Dakota are in general School Improvement, while some are in additional Comprehensive Support or Targeted Support. Our elementary school is in the Comprehensive Support category. We are eligible for \$360,000 over the span of 3 years, to be used in the elementary grades. There has been discussion on how our school could best utilize the funds to create the greatest achievement for our students. Coaching through ED Direction is required. However, we can choose the extent of the coaching. ED Direction coaching includes analysis, planning, action plans, professional learning, and coaching. The amount of funds beyond the ED Direction cost, will possibly include intervention materials and/or updating technology in the elementary classrooms. The application is due May 15, 2018.

*Title Allocations for 2018-19 look to remain similar to this school year. Title I with a 1.9% increase and Title II is level funded. Title IV funding, however, had a 75% increase. This is thought to be due in part to the nation-wide focus on school safety. 21st Century and Homeless have a slight increase in funding.

*Members of the Leadership Team attended the NDMTSS Building Academic Pathways workshop in Devils Lake on April 4th and 5th. NDMTSS is a framework that is helping our school see what is needed for a major change in order to increase achievement. This workshop provided insight as to interventions proven to work, what they should encompass, and a pathway to get there.
