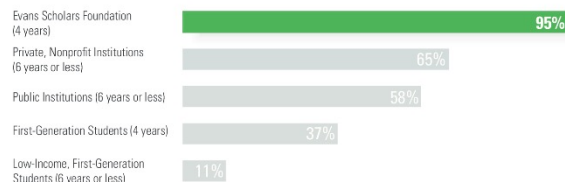

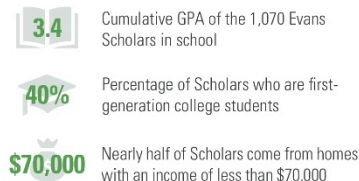
#### PROGRAM OUTCOMES

Evans Scholars graduate at a rate of **95%**, significantly higher than national averages for the student populations the Program serves. After graduation, Evans Scholars are well-prepared to build successful careers.

#### Comparison of Graduation Rates<sup>1</sup>

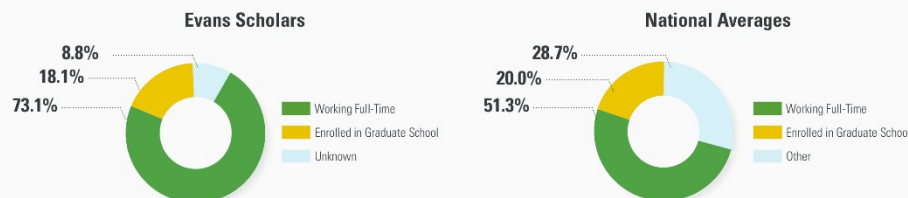


#### SCHOLARS BY THE NUMBERS



#### Status Six Months After Graduation<sup>2</sup>

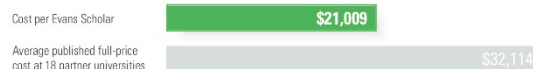
More than **91%** of Class of 2020 Evans Scholars were employed full-time or attending graduate school within six months of graduation.



#### PROGRAM EFFICIENCY

The ESF negotiates favorable tuition rates where possible, bringing the tuition and housing cost per Evans Scholar well below the approximate average cost of full-price tuition. These efforts have earned ESF a **four-star** rating from nonprofit watchdog Charity Navigator.
