

School Meals Announcement

Pekin Community High School #303 is excited to announce participation in the Seamless Summer Option (SSO) for School Year 2021-22. This means that meals will be available at no cost to all enrolled students. SSO is administered by the Illinois State Board of Education (ISBE) and funded by the U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA). SSO is traditionally a program option for schools during the summer but flexibilities due to the pandemic make it available for the upcoming year.

SSO meals are a healthy balanced selection of grains, vegetables, milk, fruits, and protein foods. Clothing, accessories, make-up, and hair color should in no way distract from the learning environment at school or school activities nor should they create a danger to the health and safety of the students.

School personnel reserve the right to make determinations on acceptable appearance and dress.

- Masks are required, and must be worn over the nose and mouth.
- Shirts with sleeves covering the entire torso and shoulders are required.
- Pants, jeans, shorts, dresses, and skirts must extend to at least mid-thigh.
- When wearing leggings (including knit jeggings) and yoga pants, the top must cover the pelvic region and buttocks.
- No pants may have holes above mid-thigh.
- No undergarments of any kind may be exposed.
- Pajamas/pajama pants are not acceptable attire.
- As a health and safety measure, all students must wear shoes. (slippers are not allowed)

Students who choose to dress in a manner not appropriate for school will be instructed to change their clothing before they will be admitted to class.




Hallway Social Distancing






