The Mercer County Career Center is excited about the return of students here in our facility on Wednesday, August 25, 2021. As COVID-19 continues to impact our region, we want to provide you with updated information regarding MCCC's strategies to keep your child safe. The information below is a summary of our Health and Safety Plan that is regularly reviewed by MCCC's Joint Operating Committee. These strategies are subject to change based on community transmission levels, PDE, PADOH, CDC, and joint school recommendations/mandates.

**Masking**

- Masking is recommended but optional for all students and staff.

**Social Distancing**

- Students will be encouraged to maintain distance to the greatest extent possible when in class, work areas, etc.

**Hand Washing/Sanitizing**

- Students should sanitize hands upon entry into classroom.
- Students will be provided handwashing breaks.
- Students will be reminded to frequently wash/sanitize hands.

**Cleaning**

- Cleaning and sanitization of classroom, restroom, hallway, and touch points per CDC recommendations will occur daily.

**Contact Tracing/Quarantine**

- MCCC will cooperate with PADOH to implement quarantines and contact tracing for sick/symptomatic individuals as they apply to vaccinated and non-vaccinated individuals.

**Screening**

- It is critically important for students to stay home regardless of whether their symptoms are indicative of COVID, influenza, or other infections that are more commonly transmitted through close personal contact.
- Parents/guardians of students are required to report positive diagnosis of COVID-19 to administration.
