JOB DESCRIPTION

Stanfield Secondary School has a vacancy for a Food Service II employee. This position is responsible for supporting the Food Services Manager in all aspects of operations pertaining to the building kitchen and food service program.

Qualifications: To perform this job successfully, an individual must be able to execute each requirement satisfactorily. The requirements listed below are representative of the knowledge, skill and/or ability needed for the position.

- 1. High School Diploma or equivalent;
- 2. Obtain and maintain a valid Food Handler's Certification;
- 3. Familiar with Hazard Analysis Critical Control Point (HACCP);
- 4. Profound and critical knowledge of USDA child nutrition guidelines and regulations;
- 5. Experience in preparing and serving food for a large number of people;
- 6. Ability to work harmoniously with others and to communicate effectively with students, parents, and teachers;
- 7. Maintain a pleasant and friendly attitude towards students, staff and co-workers;
- 8. Ability to accurately follow and complete a recipe;
- 9. Ability to follow directions;
- 10. Ability to keep school information confidential;
- 11. Maintain an appropriate level of personal hygiene necessary for a food preparation area;
- 12. Perform physical requirements which may include;
 - a. Moderate degree of physical stamina
 - b. Ability to stand, walk and bend frequently, and lifting up to 50 lbs.

Responsibilities and essential functions of the job may include but are not limited to the following: Responsibilities:

- 1. Prepare and serve food in a quick and pleasant manner;
- 2. Complete daily clean-up of utensils, equipment, kitchen and service area-including the cafeteria where students eat:
- 3. Complete daily inventory and recordkeeping duties as assigned by Food Services Manager;
- 4. Serve meals that meet the ODE required food patterns;
- 5. Store and care of food and other supplies;
- 6. Stock shelves and freezers;
- 7. Work with other kitchen staff to ensure cafeteria area is clean after meal times, including mopping after lunch each day;
- 8. Ability to use MealTime food service program and troubleshoot or improvise a system to ensure daily meals served are recorded correctly for accounting auditing purposes if MealTime is unavailable;
- 9. Supervise student helpers or assistants during the lunch period;
- 10. Complete daily reporting for meals served;
- 11. Complete ODE training requirements;
- 12. Report any maintenance problems or safety to concerns to Food Services Manager;
- 13. Communicate problems or concerns with Food Services Manager, not staff or co-workers;
- 14. Substitute for the Food Services Manager as assigned;
- 15. Other duties as assigned.
