

Reopening of Geneseo Central School Pool to the Community (COVID Protocols)

Use of Geneseo Central School Facilities

All individuals who use the district's facilities, must adhere to any applicable Executive Orders and the following NYSDOH restrictions:

- Individuals must maintain a distance of at least six feet from other individuals at all times, unless they are members of the same household or family unit.
- Individuals must wear an acceptable face covering that covers both the nose and mouth.

All individuals who enter Geneseo Central School District facilities will truthfully answer "No" to the following questions:

- Have you knowingly been in close (less than 6' for 10 minutes or more) or proximate (sustained contact for 60 minutes in the same location) contact in the past 10 days with anyone who has tested positive for COVID-19 or has had symptoms of COVID-19?
- Have you had any of the symptoms associated with COVID-19 in the past 10 days?
- Have you tested positive for COVID-19 within the last 10 days?
- Have you traveled internationally or from a state with widespread community transmission of COVID-19 per the NYS travel advisory in the past 10 days?
- Have you experienced a temperature of 100.0 F or greater in the last 24 hours?

Any individuals on district property will be required to:

- Receive a temperature reading before entering the specific location.
 - Touchless thermometers are located at each entrance.
- Properly wash hands and cover their face when coughing and/or sneezing;
- Adhere to social distancing rules;
- Wear appropriate use of face coverings;
- Abide by cleaning and disinfecting protocols.

The district will provide supplies for proper hand and respiratory hygiene, including soap, running water, and disposable paper towels; alcohol-based hand sanitizer containing at least 60% alcohol for areas where handwashing facilities may not be available or practical; and tissues and trash receptacles.

Requirements specific to the pool:

- For health and safety concerns, face coverings are not to be worn by individuals while in the water. However, individuals are required to wear face coverings when not in the water.
- No more than 2 swimmers per lane.
- Pool locker rooms will be accessible with no more than 6 individuals in the locker room at one time.
- Groups and/or individuals occupying the space will be responsible for adhering to and enforcing all guidelines.
- Safety procedures such as a rescue, override the occupancy and social distancing guidelines.
- Entering / Exiting the building: Main entrance
