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ASVAB Opt OutForm



Juniors will be taking the Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery (ASVAB) test <u>Thursday</u>, <u>April 27th</u>, 1st-3rd periods. The ASVAB test helps students identify their skills and interests so that they can find potentially satisfying career fields and explore all post-secondary paths they could take to gain entry into their career field of choice. The testing categories are: General Science, Arithmetic Reasoning, Word Knowledge, Paragraph Comprehension, Mathematics Knowledge, Electronics Information, Auto and Shop Information and Mechanical Comprehension.

- Taking the ASVAB gives a student an opportunity to explore education, work-based learning, and/or the Military in the context of their skills and interests without cost or commitment.
- The ASVAB is *not* an IQ test and taking the test does *not* obligate individuals to any military service.
