### **Aligning for Student Success Program Report**

#### **Narrative**

In 2022, the Oregon Department of Education (ODE) created the The Aligning for Student Success (AFSS) program in order to establish a more efficient process for districts to manage state grant grant programs. No new grants were offered through the AFSS; instead it combines six current programs that have common goals into one integrated plan. St. Paul School District is eligible for and receiving funds for three of the six grants in the aligned program: the Early Indicator and Intervention System (EIIS), High School Success (HSS), and Student Investment Account. As part of the new integrated plan, districts were asked to develop a four-year budget with goals supported by strategies designed to improve outcomes for all student groups. Below is an overview of the plan outcomes and budget.
