Color Run



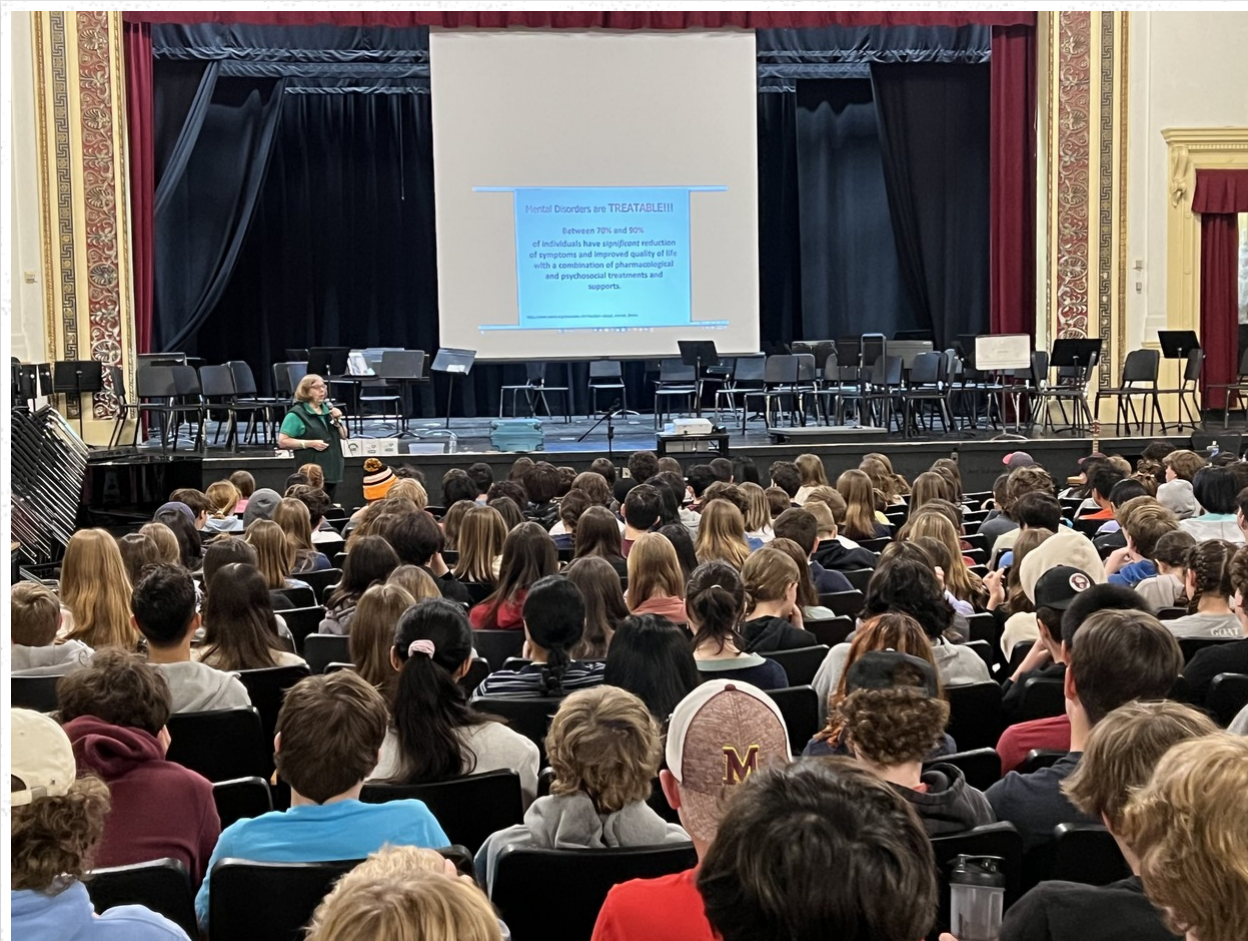

COMING UP FOR AIR

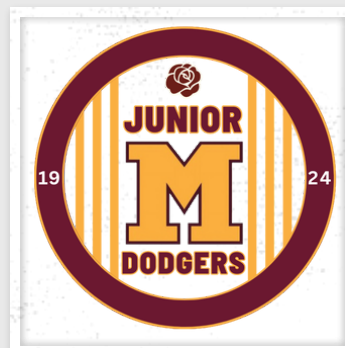
