MJS Random Acts of Kindness with Conflict Resolution

The MJS Conflict Resolution team, in partnership with the Madison Education Foundation (MEF) developed a grant based on the idea called the Butterfly Effect. This kindness initiative, which was started by Chris Rosati when he was in his 40s and diagnosed with ALS (Lou Gehrig's Disease) creates "bucket lists" that would spread kindness and happiness to others.

Students worked on their own or in small groups and applied for a mini-grants of \$50-\$100 for an idea they developed to help spread kindness or fulfill a need at MJS or our community.
