WHEREAS, the Madison Board of Education ("the Board") advertised for bids for the Rooftop Unit Replacement at the Madison High School, Madison Junior School and Tory J. Sabatini School Project ("Project");

WHEREAS, on April 14, 2023, the Board received two bids for the Project;

WHEREAS, Iron Mountain Mechanical, LLC ("Iron Mountain") submitted the lowest bid with a base bid in the amount of \$438,865, together with Alternate No. 1 in the amount of \$174,895 for a total bid in the amount of \$613,760;

WHEREAS, the bid submitted by Iron Mountain is responsive in all material respects; and

WHEREAS, the Board desires to award the contract for the Project to Iron Mountain.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board hereby awards the contract for the Project to Iron Mountain for a total contract sum of \$613,760.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this award is expressly conditioned upon the contractor furnishing the requisite insurance certificate and labor and materials/performance bond as required in the Project specifications, together with an AA201-Project Manning Report, and an executed AIA Agreement, as prepared by the Board Attorney, within ten (10) days of the date hereof.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board Attorney is hereby directed to draft the agreement with the successful bidder consistent with this Resolution and the terms contained in the bid documents and specifications for the Project. The Board President and the Board Secretary are hereby authorized to execute such agreement and any other documents necessary to effectuate the terms of this Resolution.
