Guidelines for Instruction During Mandated Quarantine



During quarantine, instruction and supports will look different based on the grade level of the student. Instruction will not be offered “live” during the instructional day during the 2021-22 SY. Below you will find the instructional expectations for both students and teachers when students are placed on quarantine due to COVID.

Students in grades 6-12 will use their district issued Chromebook to complete assignments during quarantine. Students in grades K-5 will be provided a device to use at home during quarantine. Families in need of internet access during quarantine should contact the Director of Technology, Jared Lynn, at jlynn@ms.k12.il.us.

The following options will be available for students when on quarantine due to COVID 19 exposure:

Prekindergarten

- Activity packets that can be completed with adult support will be available for pick up and/or mailed.
- Classroom teachers will be available for questions from parents via telephone, email or the Remind app before/after school.

Students Grades K-5

- Instructional materials/lessons will be available for pickup and/or available in Google Classroom. Work should be completed on the day it is assigned unless additional support is needed. If additional help is needed, work should be completed following the Homework Help Meet.
- Students absent due to illness, be it COVID or other illness, in general, will be provided one make up day for work for every day of illness.
- Classroom teachers will be available to answer questions from students in Google Classroom by appointment after school (Gr. K-2 - 2:30-3:00; Gr. 3-5 - 2:40-3:10).
- Classroom teachers will be available for questions from parents via telephone and email before/after school (Gr. K-5). Emails and phone calls will be returned by the end of the next school day.

- Classroom/homework help by a certified staff member will be available during Google Meet Tuesdays, Wednesday, and Thursday from 6:00-7:30 PM. The link for the Homework Help Meet will be provided to quarantine families.

Students Grades 6-12

- Assignments will be posted by 4:00 daily.
- Students that are COVID positive will follow the guidelines for student absence with regards to missing work. Students that are quarantined but not COVID positive will be responsible for keeping up with classwork. When additional assistance is needed, classwork will be due the next day following Homework Help Meet.
- Students on quarantine will not be found ineligible due to missing tests/quizzes that need to be taken upon returning to school. Students not positive will have three days to complete all tests and quizzes that were not available via Google Classroom or other electronic platform. Students COVID positive will follow the guidelines for student absence to complete missing tests and quizzes.
- Teachers will be available to answer questions from students in Google Classroom by appointment after school (Gr. 6-8 - 3:22-3:52; Gr. 9-12 - 3:12-3:42).
- Teachers will be available for questions from parents and students via telephone and email before/after school. Emails and phone calls will be returned by the end of the next school day.
- Classroom/Homework Help Meet by a certified staff member will be available during Google Meet Tuesdays, Wednesday, and Thursday from 6:00-7:30 PM. The link for the Homework Help Meet will be provided to quarantined families.

Students with Individualized Education Plans

Families of students with IEPs, at all levels, will receive information from their case manager about services during quarantine.
