Activities Events	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>White River School District will use a tier system of deciding if and when spectators will be allowed into each venue.</li> <li><b>Tier I Open Attendance-</b> Watching events on livestream is encouraged.</li> <li><b>Tier II- Open Attendance-</b> Masks are required for all spectators and workers at indoor events including those attending from visiting schools.</li> <li><b>Tier III</b> A determined # of tickets provided to each participant. WRHS students may attend without a ticket and must sit in the student section. PK-8 do not need a ticket but must be accompanied by and sit with a parent. The same number of tickets would be provided to the visiting team.</li> </ul>
Masks	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>Tier I</b> Masks are not required if the school is in Phase 1.</li> <li><b>Tier II and III</b> Masks are required for all spectators and workers at indoor events including those attending from visiting schools if the school is in Phase 2 and 3.</li> <li>Masks and social distancing are recommended at outdoor events.</li> <li>Masks are required during the school day when not able to social distance.</li> <li>Masks are required when reporting to an activity before doing the screening.</li> <li>Masks will be worn while being transported in any school provided transportation.</li> <li>Masks are not required for participants during physical activity.</li> <li>Masks are required to be worn by all bench personnel including coaches and any bench personnel that are not actively participating in the contest. Masks must be worn covering the nose and mouth.</li> </ul>
Visitors to School Attendance at Events	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>Tier I-</b> Concessions will be available.</li> <li><b>Tier II-</b> Concessions will be available.</li> <li><b>Tier III-</b> No concessions will be available.</li> <li>Refillable water bottles are allowed.</li> <li>Health Screenings are recommended for spectators.</li> <li>Contact less thermometers will be available.</li> </ul>
Health Screening Athletes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>Tier I-</b> Parents/students will do self-screenings before every event.</li> <li><b>Tier II-</b> Parents/students will do self-screenings before every event.</li> <li><b>Tier III-</b> Every student will be screened before every practice to ensure that they do not have any of the symptoms of COVID 19.</li> <li>Every student will be screened before they load the bus for out of town trips.</li> <li>Every student will be screened before they play in an athletic contest.</li> <li>Temperature and symptoms check will be done during every screening process.</li> </ul>
Cleaning/Sanitizing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Hand sanitizer will be located in hallways, near bathrooms and locker rooms.</li> <li>Outside air intake will be increased in all buildings.</li> <li>The use of disinfecting solutions will be utilized on a more frequent basis.</li> <li>Custodial procedures and frequency of sanitizing will be increased.</li> <li>Water fountains will be turned off and bottle fillers will be readily available.</li> <li>Students will be provided personal water bottles. Sharing is not allowed.</li> <li>Athletes will be encouraged to only use the restrooms within their own locker rooms both during home events and when traveling. Do not use the public rest rooms.</li> </ul>
Response to Students who become COVID symptomatic during the day	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>White River School District will follow guidance in the WRSD Start School Plan 21-22.</li> <li>If an athlete or staff member becomes sick with COVID-19 symptoms during the practice or event, the athlete will be sent home and encouraged to contact their health provider.</li> <li>Affected areas will be thoroughly cleaned.</li> </ul>

Positive Cases and Response	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• White River School District will follow guidance in the WRSD Start School Plan 21-22.</li> <li>• Refer to the WRSD Start School Plan on Exclusion from School and Close Contact Tracing on page 5.</li> </ul>
Social Distancing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Social distancing of 3 feet will be expected when possible.</li> <li>• Signs will be placed around the activities venues expressing the importance of social distancing.</li> </ul>
Game Management	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Indoor Events: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Tier I-</b> Event workers will be responsible to do self-screenings before the event.</li> <li>• <b>Tier II-</b> Event workers will be responsible to do self-screenings before the event. Event workers will be required to wear masks.</li> <li>• <b>Tier III-</b> All event workers and officials will be screened before each competition.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• Announcer will be placed on a separate table behind the head score table.</li> <li>• Each team will be responsible for filling individual water bottles for each player.</li> <li>• Starting line ups will be read aloud, however no team tunnels. Follow each individual sports recommendations. Teams will refrain from having whole group cheers.</li> <li>• Outside radio announcers will be spread out within the gym area.</li> <li>• Signs will be posted to recommend social distancing.</li> <li>• No shaking hands/high fives with the opposing team(s) after the event.</li> <li>• Outdoor Events: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Tier I-</b> Event workers will be responsible to do self-screenings before the event.</li> <li>• <b>Tier II-</b> Event workers will be responsible to do self-screenings before the event.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• Announcer will be placed with maximum distance allowed for social distancing.</li> <li>• Starting line ups will be read aloud, however no team tunnels. Follow each individual sports recommendations. Teams will refrain from having whole group cheers.</li> <li>• Radio announcers may be asked to set up on the outside of the crowd's nest.</li> <li>• Each team will be responsible for filling individual water bottles for each player.</li> <li>• Signs will be posted to recommend social distancing.</li> <li>• No shaking hands/high fives with the opposing team(s) after the event.</li> </ul>
Transportation Safety/ Sanitation	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Tier I-</b> Masks are not required if the school is in Phase 1.</li> <li>• <b>Tier II and III-</b> Masks are required if the school is in Phase 2.</li> <li>• Students, drivers, and bus monitors will be required to wear masks during all transportation provided by the White River School District.</li> <li>• Seating assignments will be the same for each trip.</li> <li>• Parents may request permission to transport students to and from extra-curricular events.</li> <li>• All students, drivers and bus monitors will be required to be screened before entering the bus for all trips. This will include taking temperature and answering symptom questions.</li> <li>• Buses/vehicles will be cleaned and sanitized after every use.</li> </ul>
Facility usage by outside organizations	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Tier I-</b> Facility use can be requested according to the Facility Use Agreement.</li> <li>• <b>Tier II-</b> School facilities will be limited to school sponsored events.</li> <li>• At this time school facilities will be limited to school sponsored events.</li> <li>• When and if outside groups are permitted to use school facilities, they will follow all current school district policies and procedures.</li> </ul>
