### **Entrance to Buildings Protocols - Student Arrival/Dismissal** NGS - Arrival: ☐ Students will arrive at school through the main entrance at staggered times. Busses will arrive first and be cleared. ■ Walkers/Drop offs please arrive by 7:55 am. Please use sidewalks and crosswalks. NGS - Dismissal: ☐ Students will be dismissed one bus at a time. ☐ After all busses are clear - walkers will be dismissed out the cafe door following social distancing ☐ Car riders - will be dismissed after buses clear the parking lot Please use sidewalks and crosswalks. MJH - Arrival: ☐ Students riding the shuttle bus to MJH need to be at NGS no later than 7:45 am. ■ Students may arrive at MJH at 7:50 am. Parents/Guardians should drop off students in the gravel West side parking lot. Do not enter the front parking lot during the times of 7:45 am - 8:05 am and 2:45 pm - 3:05 pm. This is strictly for the buses. MJH - Dismissal: ■ Bus riders will be dismissed first by bus through the front entrance. ☐ Walkers and car riders will be dismissed by grade out the North door by the sports entrance. ☐ All pick up/drop offs at MJH should use the side gravel parking lot. □ Do not enter the front parking lot during the times of 7:45 am - 8:05 am and 2:45 pm - 3:05 pm. This is strictly for the buses. Visitors Nonessential visitors, volunteers and activities involving external organizations with people who are not fully vaccinated are discouraged from entering the buildings. Unless parents are picking up their child, appointments are highly encouraged. ☐ Visitors will have to answer the COVID19 screening questions before entering the buildings. Students with a fever, loss of taste/smell, sore throat, and/or body aches will require clearance from a medical provider before returning to school. For these specific symptoms, vaccinated students may return after 24 hours of no symptoms. If you are sick, please stay home. ☐ Students with a cough, runny nose, vomiting, and/or diarrhea will require 24 hours of no symptoms before returning. This is true for all students, regardless of vaccination status. ☐ Siblings without symptoms may come to school. ☐ If anyone in the student's household tests positive for Covid, the student must quarantine for 14 days. Fully vaccinated children in the same household will not need to quarantine if they are without symptoms.

Please remember to certify your child's symptoms in Teacherease by 6:30 am for bus riders and 7:00 am for walkers/drop offs. .






## Don't miss any updates from Newark!

# Help Is Here

## Monthly payments for families with kids

Raising kids can be expensive, and the Child Tax Credit is here to help. President Biden's American Rescue Plan increased the amount of the 2021 Child Tax Credit to support families with children.

The full benefit of the Child Tax Credit is now \$300 per month per child under age 6 and \$250 for each child age 6 to 17.

# Did you file taxes in the last 2 years? Then you don't have to do anything to get the money you're already owed!

If you filed your 2020 taxes this year or filed your 2019 taxes last year, or used the IRS "Non-Filer Portal" to get a stimulus check last year, you don't need to do anything. The IRS will automatically send you a monthly payment by direct deposit or check starting on July 15, 2021.

# The Child Tax Credit is \$3,000 to \$3,600 per child with advanced monthly payments.

In order to get money to families quickly, the IRS will pay half of the credit as monthly payments now and the other half when you file your taxes next year. In total, you'll receive a total of \$3,600 for each child under 6 and \$3,000 for each child between 6 and 17.

# Didn't file taxes in the last 2 years? There's 1 easy step to start getting your Child Tax Credit payments.

Just fill out a simple form to begin receiving your monthly Child Tax Credit payments. You can access it by going to childtaxcredit.gov

#### You'll need this information to apply:

- Social Security Numbers for you and your children
- A reliable mailing address
- E-mail address
- Your bank account information (if you want to receive your payment by direct deposit)

**Eligibility:** Most families, even those with little to no income, can receive the full amount. If you are a single parent making less than \$112,500 or a married couple making less than \$150,000—and have children under age 18 who will live with you for more than half of 2021—you are likely eligible for the full benefit. These benefits do not affect your eligibility for other federal benefits like SNAP.
