Facilities: Don Alamieda presented an overview of the districts' needs and the general plan. He estimates that the total need is for 14 million dollars of upgrades. The Bond measure will give us 5.5 million, so it will be necessary to prioritize. The funds will go primarily to the Elementary site. The oldest buildings (the incline) will be addressed first along with campus wide Fire alarm and PA system. Mr. Alamieda showed some graphics of possible classroom designs. He was asked to do some cost comparisons of different options. There will be a community meeting March 4th at 7pm in the MPR where he will make the same presentation and ask for input.
