Policy for Providing Free Meals for School Divisions Participating in the Seamless Summer Option for all Schools in the Division (Divisionwide)

Lancaster County Public schools, today announced its policy for providing meals for children served under the National School Lunch, and/or School Breakfast Programs. All schools in the division will be participating in the Seamless Summer Option (SSO) as implemented under the Healthy, Hunger-Free Kids Act of 2010. Enrolled students will be provided a nutritious meal for breakfast and lunch each day at no charge to the household. Households will not be required to submit a meal application form to receive meals at no charge. Each school and/or central school nutrition office has a copy of the policy, which may be reviewed by any interested party.
