Dear Parents/Guardians:

As we begin summer vacation, we are opening bus pass registration for the FY 2023- 2024 school year. Bus pass registration will still be done online through www.FamilyID.com. You will need your Student ID number to register. The Student ID number is provided by your student's school and is also listed on Aspen. Please note that each student must be registered separately in Family ID and payments must be made through MySchoolBucks at the end of the registration process.

The Transportation/Bus User Fee for students in grades Kindergarten through Grade 12 for the 2023-2024 school year will be \$150.00 per student with a family maximum of \$600.00. **There is no bus fee for students in Grades K-6 who live two or more miles from their assigned school. Students who have applied for and are eligible for free or reduced lunch will be issued a bus pass at no charge. You must submit a new application each year.** Paper applications are available at each school. To apply online, please go to:

Please be advised of the following:

- **Students must register for a bus pass by August 15th.** The bus company needs time to set up routes. We will not guarantee a bus pass to anyone who registers after August 15th. Students must have a bus pass in their possession in order to ride the bus.
- **Bus passes will be mailed to families using the address entered into Family ID during registration.**
