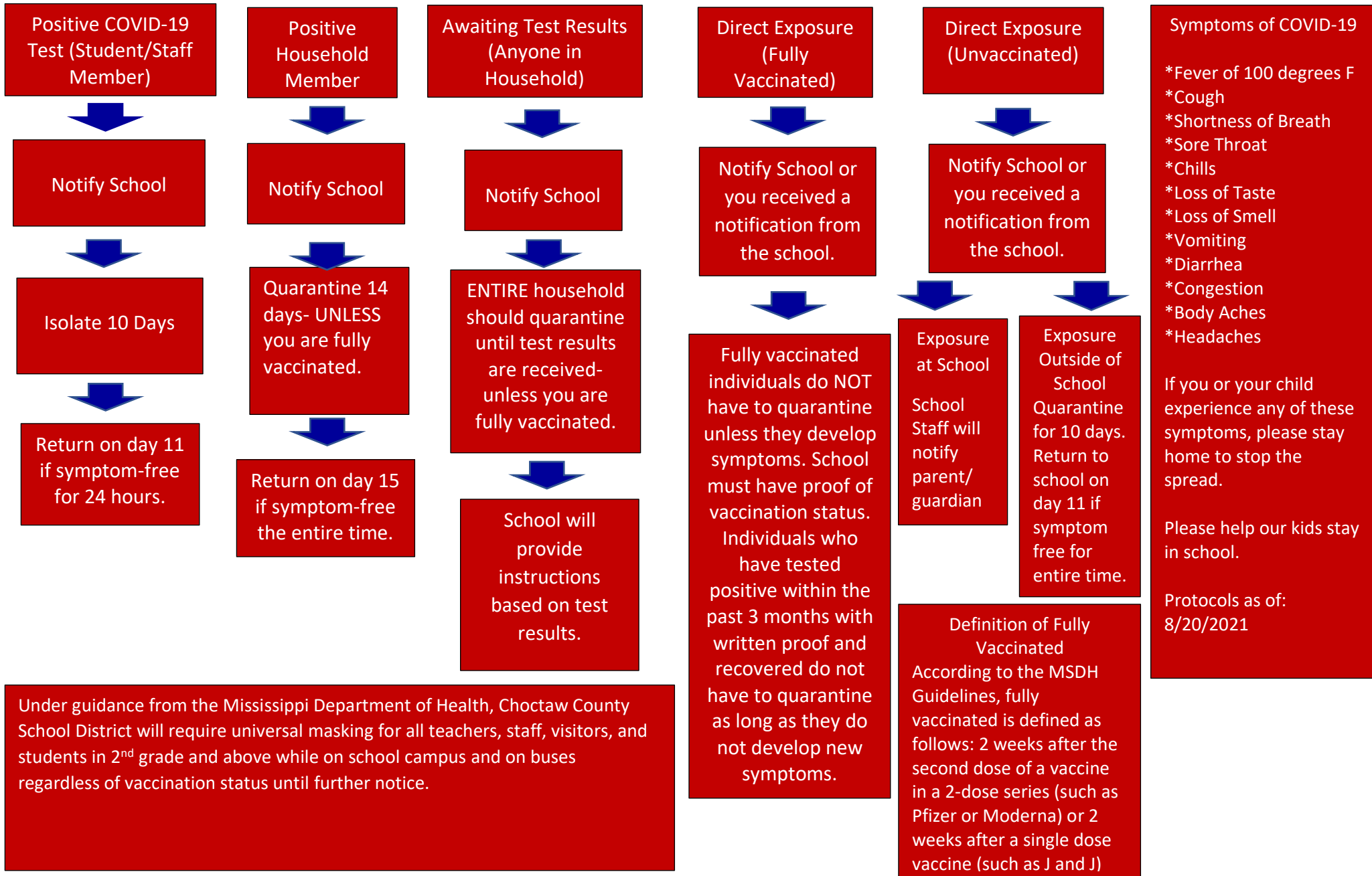

Protocols as of: 8/20/2021

Under guidance from the Mississippi Department of Health, Choctaw County School District will require universal masking for all teachers, staff, visitors, and students in 2nd grade and above while on school campus and on buses regardless of vaccination status until further notice.

Definition of Fully Vaccinated
 According to the MSDH Guidelines, fully vaccinated is defined as follows: 2 weeks after the second dose of a vaccine in a 2-dose series (such as Pfizer or Moderna) or 2 weeks after a single dose vaccine (such as J and J)
