

## NOTICE OF ELECTION

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a polling place election will be held in and for the Beaverhead County High School to submit to the Beaverhead County High School District the question of whether or not to levy a tax in the amount of \$44,055.52. The Beaverhead County High School Mill Levy Election will be held on the 8<sup>th</sup> day of May.

The question shall be presented to the electors in the following form:

Shall the district be authorized to impose an increase in local taxes to support the general fund in the amount of \$44,055.52 which is approximately 2.23 mills for the purpose of providing instruction, maintenance, and operation of the school district.

Passage of this proposal will increase the taxes on a home with a market value of \$100,000 by approximately \$3.01 and on a home with a market value of \$200,000 by approximately \$6.02. The duration limit of the levy is permanent once approved by the voters, assuming the district levies that amount at least once in the next five years.

The election will be conducted by polling place election. Absentee ballots will be mailed to all absentee voters in the District on April 20, 2018. There will be **one polling place open for voting on Election Day. The BW Lodge Gymnasium will be open for voting from 7:00 AM until 8:00 PM.**

If you missed the regular registration deadline, you may still register for the election by showing up at the county election office up to and including on Election Day. Between noon and the close of business on the day before Election Day, you can complete and submit a voter registration card, but you will need to return to the local election office on Election Day to pick up and vote a ballot.

Persons who wish to register and who are not presently registered may do so by requesting a form for registration by mail or by appearing at the county election office. If you have moved, please update your registration information by filling out a new voter registration card and submitting it to the county election office.

Absentee ballots and polling place ballots will be transported to the Beaverhead County Courthouse Commissioners Room on Election Day for a central count. A counting board consisting of three counting judges will use a DS450 tabulating machine to count all ballots.
