Resolution, No. 1.

Changing the parking order from the center of the Streets to the Curb.

Be it resolved by the Board of trustees of the Town of Fleming, Colorado, (that part of)
THAT section six of ordinance seven(7), which reads as follows: "All moter vehicles of any kind or nature shall be parked on the main street in the following manner, to-wit: By being left in the center of the street or as nearly the center as possible and all motor vehicles shall keep to the right of the center of the said street and motor vehicled which have been parked shall be with drawn from the parking in such a manner as to allow them to travel on the right hand side of the center of the said street. "be changed to read in the following manner: All motor vehicles of any kind or nature shall be parked on the main street in the following manner, to-wit; by being left with with left from wheel against the curbing at such an angle that the vehicle can be withdrawn from the parking in such a manner as to allow them to travel on the right side of the street", and that this resolution become effective on the twenty-second day of Oct. 1920, after being published in the

offecial Fleming Paper.
