QUALIFICATIONS AND DUTIES OF BUS DRIVERS

QUALIFICATIONS

- 1. School bus drivers must be at least twenty-five (25) years old, possess a class B commercial license, and have not less than five (5) years of driving experience with an unrestricted operator's license; ¹
- 2. Annual physical and mental examinations are required for all school bus drivers; 2.3
- 3. Substitutes or alternative drivers shall meet all qualifications and requirements for regular drivers.

DUTIES

- 1. Neat appearance, courteous to parents and children and cooperative with teachers and school officials;
- 2. Participate in the state-sponsored driver training program;
- 3. Perform pre and post trip daily vehicle inspections per federal regulations;
- 4. Obey all state and local traffic regulations and shall assist motorists in passing the school bus between stops;
- 5. Wear seat belts at all times when such belts are provided;
- 6. Remain on buses while students are on the bus, including loading and unloading;
- 7. Promote safety habits with the group of students he/she transports;
- 8. Report any misconduct of student to the principal of the school to which the student belongs or to the transportation supervisor;
- 9. School bus drivers shall not use profanity when children are being transported;
- 10. Bus drivers shall not use tobacco in any form while on the bus and shall not be under the influence of any intoxicating drink or other drug;
- 11. Sweep and clean the bus at least once each day;
- 12. Wash your assigned bus once per month
- 13. Fuel your bus as needed, and
- 14. Shall be responsible for checking the bus at the end of every run to ensure that all students have left the bus.
