Vysehrad ISD Board Approved COVID-19 Policy

- Masks are recommended but not required in accordance with the Governor's order prohibiting mask mandates.
- 2. Non-household close contacts of a confirmed positive case in the school will be notified and parents given the option to quarantine their child or send them back to school with daily symptom monitoring by the nurse for 10 days from the last date of contact.
- 3. COVID positive staff or students will be required to quarantine for 10 days from the onset of symptoms or as stated by their doctor's note.
- 4. Household members of a positive family member will be quarantined for 10 days from the onset of the positive person's symptoms and will be monitored for symptoms by the nurse for the remaining 4 days upon return to school.
- 5. Any student or staff exhibiting signs or symptoms of COVID will be sent home by the nurse and a doctor's note will be required to return to work or school.
- 6. If your child has symptoms of COVID-19 and does not feel well, please DO NOT send him/her to school and compromise the health and safety of all other students and staff members. Contact your health care provider and seek guidance.
