ORDINANCE NUMBER TWELVE, TOWN OF FLEMING.

An ordinance relating to pool and billiard halls, prohibiting the the operation of a pool hall without license.

Be it ordained by the board of trustees of the town of Fleming.

Section 1. All persons are hereby prohitited from keeping or operating any pool halls, bowling alley, pigeonhole table, or other similar device withinh the town of Fleming, without having first procured a license therefor as hereinafter provided.

Section 2. The following license shall be paid by any person or persons permitted to operate a pool or billiard hall within the Town of Fleming, upon the written application of any person to the Town of Fleming, and payment of the following sums for one menth to-wit;

The sum of Five Dollars per table for one month, payable monthly in advance.

Section 3. No game shall be started after the hour of eleven O'clock

P.M., and all tables must be covered by the hour of eleventhirty and remain

closed until six O'clock a.m. the next succeeding day, excepting when the succeeding day comes on Sunday, when the said hall shall remain closed until the following

Monday morning at six o'clock a.m.

Section 4. No pool or billiard halls, bowling alleys, or other similar devises shall have any screen upon or blinds over the windows of the said hall or halls.

Section 5. The owners or operators of all pool and billiard halls, or other similar halls, licensed as aforesaid, shall not keep any drinks of any nature or description other than water and soft drinks in said halls, or permit the same to be kept there by any other person or persons, and shall not allow gambling of any description, but the paying of the usual price for games shall not be deemed gambling.

Section 6. No minor under eighteen years of age shall be allowed to remain in the said hall or halls or participate in the games. Those over eighteen years of age and under tweety-one years of age are not allowed to remain in said halls or participate in any games without the personal consent of their parents or guardian.

Section 7. The owner or operators of any pool or billiard hall or other similar halls, shall not have any private rooms in connection with said pool or billiard halls or any card rooms in connection therewith, or permit games of cards to be played therein.

Section 8. All applicants for licenses for any pool or billiard hall or other similar halls, shall be required to give a good and sufficient bond to the Town of Fleming in the sum of \$500.00 before license shall be granted to the said applicants.

Section 9. Anyone violating any of the provisions of this ordinance thall, upon conviction thereof, be fined in a sum of not less than \$10.00 nor more than \$200.00 and costs of suit and shall stand committed to jail until such fine and costs are paid, and, in addition thereto, in the discretion of the board of Trustees, may have his license revoked.

Section 10. All licenses shall be paid cash in advance for one month.

All licenses may be revoked at any time by the Board of Trustees.
