

ORDINANCE NO. 15

AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING RAILROAD TRAINS.

BE it ordained by The Board of Trustees of The Town of Fleming, Colorado:

Section 1. No railroad company or corporation shall obstruct any street within the Town of Fleming by stopping any train upon or by leaving any car or locomotive engine standing on its track, where the same intersects or crosses any street, except for the purpose of receiving or discharging passengers, or to receive the necessary fuel and water, and in no case to exceed FIVE minutes for each train, car or locomotive engine.

The leaving of an opening of less than eighty feet in or near the center of the street shall be deemed a violation of this ordinance; said opening to clear the roadway and the sidewalks.

Section 2. No railroad company or corporation, trainmen, switchmen or other agents or employees of such company shall make or cause to be made, any flying switch of cars or locomotive within the corporate limits of the Town of Fleming, unless a brakeman or other person in the employ of the road shall be upon the rear or upon the forward portion of such car or train; and the locomotive bell shall be kept ringing continuously while at all times the engine or locomotive shall be moving within the corporate limits of the Town of Fleming.

Section 3. Every conductor, engineer, or other person in the control or management of a train of cars, locomotive or engine or cars, who shall be found guilty of a violation of this ordinance shall be fined for each and every offense not less than Three Dollars nor more than One Hundred Dollars.
