

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE SUBMISSION TO THE VOTE OF THE DULY QUALIFIED ELECTORS OF THE TOWN OF FLEMING, COLORADO, WHO ARE TAX PAYERS UNDER THE LAW, AT A SPECIAL ELECTION TO BE HELD IN SAID TOWN ON Tuesday, The 30th. Day of December, A. D. 1919, the Question of Authorizing the Board of Trustees of said Town To Erect Waterworks For Fire and Domestic Purposes, To be Owned, Managed and Operated by the Town.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of The Town of Fleming, Colorado:

Section 1. That a special election to be held in said Town on Tuesday, the 30th. day of December, A. D. 1919, the question of authorizing the Board of Trustees of the Town of Fleming, to erect waterworks for fire and domestic purposes, to be owned, managed and operated by the town, be, and the same is, hereby submitted to such voters of said town as are taxpayers under the law, for their determination.

Section 2. The question so submitted shall be voted on at said election by the voters qualified as aforesaid, at the office of Munday and Horn, in the Town of Fleming, Colorado. The vote shall be by ballot of the form hereinafter provided, and said election shall be in all respects, as nearly as may be, held and conducted in the manner prescribed by law in cases of election for municipal officers. The ballots shall be deposited in a separate ballot box which shall be provided for such purpose by the Town Clerk.

Section 3. The ballots to be used in voting upon the question above submitted shall be prepared and furnished by the Town Clerk to the judges of election, to be by them furnished to the voters and shall be in the following form:

OFFICIAL BALLOT

FOR AUTHORIZING WATERWORKS AT A SPECIAL ELECTION TO BE HELD IN THE TOWN OF FLEMING ON TUESDAY, THE 30th. DAY OF DECEMBER, A. D. 1919.

Question Submitted:

Shall the Board of Trustees of the Town of Fleming be authorized to erect and construct a system of waterworks for fire and domestic purposes, to be owned, managed and operated by the Town.

Against the erection and construction of a system of waterworks for fire and domestic purposes, to be owned, managed and operated by the town.

Each elector shall prepare his ballot, indicating his approval or disapproval of the proposition submitted by placing a cross (X) opposite the group of words which expresses his choice and shall then deposit his ballot in the separate ballot box provided for such purpose.

Section 4. No ballot for or against said question shall be received by the judges unless the person offering the same shall be a voter of the Town of Fleming and a taxpayer under the law.

Section 5. The election upon the proposition aforesaid shall be conducted by Albert Worthly, M. O'Leary and I. R. Boyce, judges, and L. R. Knight and B. S. Munday, clerks of the election.

The vote cast at said election on the question aforesaid shall be canvassed and returned, and the return made and the result declared in the same manner, as nearly as may be as provided by law for the canvass, return and declaring the result of votes cast at an election of municipal officers.

Section 6. A notice of the time and place of said election shall be published in The Fleming News, a newspaper of general circulation, printed in the Town of Fleming, in the County of Logan, and State of Colorado, at least fifteen (15) days before such election, and also a copy of such notice shall be posted at the place of voting at least fifteen (15) days before such election, announcing the time, place and object of the election, and the clerk of said Board of Trustees is hereby charged with the duty of effectuating this provision, which said notice shall be in the following form, to-wit:

ELECTION NOTICE

Pursuant to Ordinance No. 16 of The Town of Fleming, Colorado, adopted and approved the 1st. day of December, A. D. 1919, public notice is hereby given that at a special election to be held in said Town on Tuesday, the 30th. day of December, A. D. 1919, there will be submitted to the voters of the Town of Fleming who are taxpayers under the law, the following question:

Shall the Board of Trustees of the Town of Fleming be authorized to erect and construct a system of waterworks for fire and domestic purposes, to be owned, managed and operated by the town?

The question so submitted will be voted on at said election by the voters of the Town of Fleming who are taxpayers under the law at the office of Munday and Horn in the Town of Fleming, Colorado.

The term taxpayer under the law shall be held to mean and include only those persons who are qualified voters under the registration and election laws of this State and who, in the calendar year last preceeding the said election, shall have paid a tax, or be liable for the payment of such tax, upon real or personal property assessed to them and owned by them in said Town.

Seperate ballots to be used in voting upon the question above submitted will be furnished to the voters by the judges of election, to be deposited in a seperate ballot box which will be provided for that purpose.

The polls will be opened at seven o'clock in the morning and continue open until seven o'clock in the evening of said day.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, The Board of Trustees of the Town of Fleming, in the State of Colorado, has caused this notice to be published and posted as required by law this 1st. day of December A. D. 1919.

Section 7. This ordinance after its passage, shall be recorded in a book kept for that purpose, be authenticated by the signature of the Mayor and Clerk, and shall be published in the Fleming News, a newspaper published within the limits of the Town of Fleming.

Section 8. This ordinance being an ordinance calling a special election shall take effect and be in force upon the expiration of five (5) days after it has been so published.
