

ORDINANCE NO. 20, 1920.

CONCERNING THE RUNNING AT LARGE OF CHICKENS AND OTHER DOMESTIC FOWLS.

Be it ordained by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Fleming:

Section 1. It is hereby declared a nuisance for chickens, ducks, geese, turkeys, or other domestic fowls to run at large within the Town of Fleming, Colorado, and all persons keeping any such domestic fowls, who shall permit the same to run at large, or trespass upon the premises of others, shall be deemed to be guilty of maintaining a nuisance and, on conviction thereof, shall be fined in any sum not less than One Dollar nor more than Twenty-five Dollars for each offense.
