

ORDINANCE NO. 21^A 1921.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE
TOWN OF FLEMING, COLORADO:

SECTION 1: No person within the corporate limits of the Town of Fleming shall keep about his place of business, dwelling house, or elsewhere, any garbage, tin cans, or refuse of any kind or nature, unless the same shall be enclosed in containers, which shall be constructed in such a manner as to prevent the escape of fumes from any garbage or refuse.

SECTION 2: In all cases where garbage is accumulated by hotels, public boarding houses, restaurants, or eating houses of any kind or character, all of said garbage and refuse shall be emptied and disposed of and removed from the premises where the same has been accumulated at least once each week.

SECTION 3: Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of maintaining a nuisance, and the said nuisance may be immediately abated by the health officer of the said town, or the town marshal, and all expense of the abating of the said nuisance shall be charged against the property of the person so offending, and shall be collected in like manner as assessments for the construction of sidewalks; and, in addition to the abating of the said nuisance, such person shall, upon conviction, be fined in a sum of not less than two dollars (\$2.00) and not more than ten dollars (\$10.00) for each and every offense, together with costs, and shall stand committed to jail until the fine and costs are paid; but in no case shall commitment to jail extend beyond a period of ten (10) days.
