Bullying/Harassment		BUL	The unwanted, aggressive behavior among students that involves a real or perceived power imbalance. The behavior is repeated, or has the potential to be repeated, over time. Possession of Weapons		POS	Student brings a weapons to school in either their book bag or on their person. This would be an object that serves no purpose at school and is designed in a way that could cause physical harm to others. The Principal may adjust consequence depending on how they gain knowledge of the weapon.
