- After August 27th you will receive an email indicating your permit is ready for pick up in the Dean's Office. Be sure to watch  your emails daily!

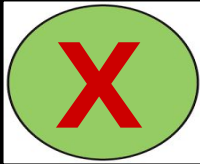

Clothing, accessories, make-up, and hair color should in no way distract from the learning environment at school or school activities nor should they create a danger to the health and safety of the students.

School personnel reserve the right to make determinations on acceptable appearance and dress.

- Masks are required, and must be worn over the nose and mouth.
- Shirts with sleeves covering the entire torso and shoulders are required.
- Pants, jeans, shorts, dresses, and skirts must extend to at least mid-thigh.
- When wearing leggings (including knit jeggings) and yoga pants, the top must cover the pelvic region and buttocks.
- No pants may have holes above mid-thigh.
- No undergarments of any kind may be exposed.
- Pajamas/pajama pants are not acceptable attire.
- As a health and safety measure, all students must wear shoes. (slippers are not allowed)

Students who choose to dress in a manner not appropriate for school will be instructed to change their clothing before they will be admitted to class.

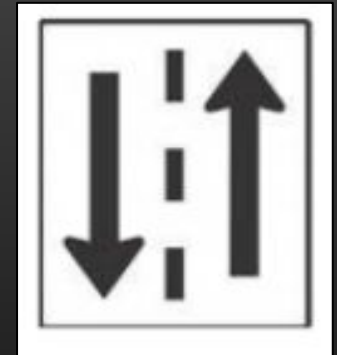

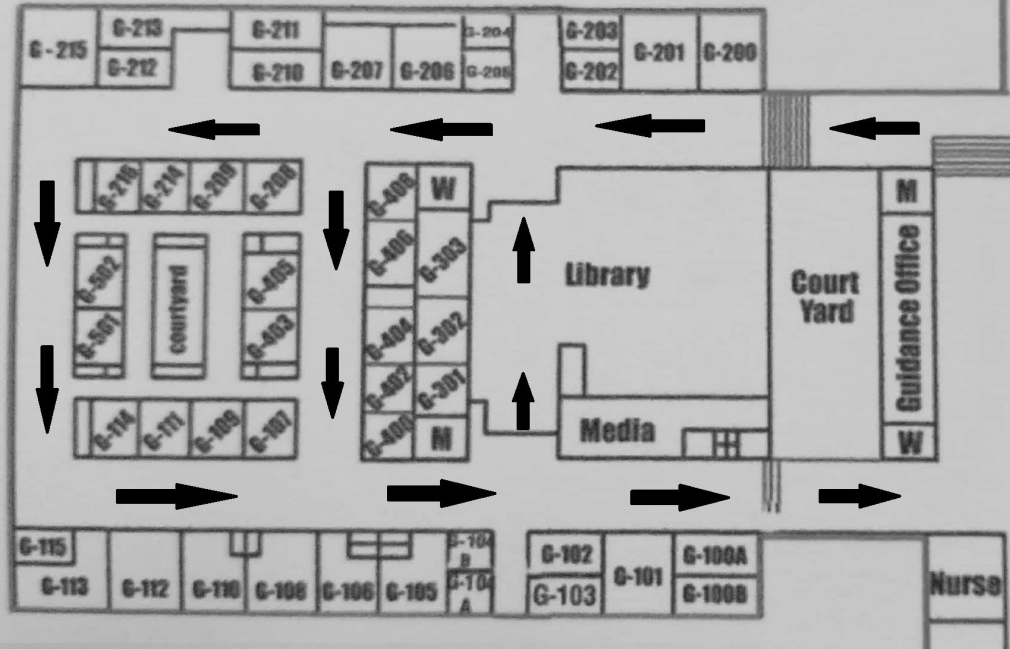
Hallway Social Distancing

A Sanctuary for Koholā - Humpback Whales

Born in Hawaii!
The waters around Hawaii are important habitat for the North Pacific population of humpback whales, known as koholā in Hawaiian. After being hunted to near extinction, they were afforded international protection. This population is recovering, and about 10,000 humpback whales return every year to Hawaii. Still, whales face threats from humans, including entanglement and vessel strikes.

Long-distance Travelers
From November through April, humpbacks are found in Hawaii where they organically mating, birthing and nursing their young. They swim about 5,000 miles to waters near Alaska where they spend the summer months feeding on krill and small fish.

A Special Place
The Hawaiian Islands Humpback Whale National Marine Sanctuary was originally created to promote management, research, and monitoring for the protection of the endangered humpback whale and its habitat. The sanctuary is jointly managed by NOAA and the State of Hawaii to protect whales and other marine life.

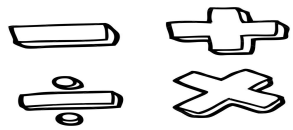

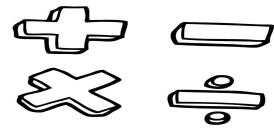

AP EXAM REGISTRATION -- Aug 19th-Oct. 15th!!

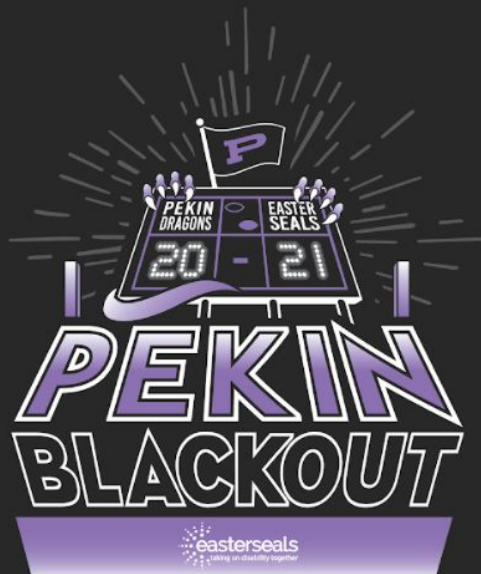
- ❖ Any student enrolled in an AP course has had the AP exam fee(s) added to their Skyward Account.
