## LAYTONVILLE BOOSTER CLUB Scholarship Criteria

- 1. Applicant must be a graduating senior.
- 2. Laytonville Booster Club must receive a written application form. The application must be neat and legible, preferably typewritten.
- 3. Application must provide two letters of recommendation. Letters may be from coaches, teachers, administration, past employers and/or community members. At least one letter must be from a Laytonville Unified School District employee.
- 4. Applicant must provide the written application form and letters by the deadlines date set by L.H.S. Counseling Department.
- 5. Applicant must have a cumulative G.P.A. of at least 2.0. The L.H.S. counseling Department will make the G.P.A. determination. Points will be awarded based on the cumulative G.P.A.
- 6. Points will be awarded based on applicant's participation in the L.H.S. sports program throughout their high school career.
- 7. Points will be awarded based on students participation with the Laytonville Booster Club events, such as volunteering in a concession stand, helping set-up and/or clean-up at sports banquet; help with unloading products, etc.
- 8. Points will be awarded based on parent/guardian's participation with the Laytonville booster club events, such as volunteering in a concession stand, helping with the set-up/take down at the sports banquet, providing baked goods and/or entrees, etc.
- 9. Points will be awarded based on the student's participation and presentation at Scholarship Night.
- 10. The Laytonville booster club committee will review all applications. They will attend Scholarship Night and make recommendations to the Laytonville Booster Club at their scheduled meeting.
- 11. Proof of registration into a school of higher education may be requested prior to any scholarship funding being issued.
- 12. Scholarship amount may be awarded into payments. Recipients must provide  $2^{nd}$  semester registration prior to  $2^{nd}$  payment being issued.
- 13. Laytonville Booster Club reserves the right to revoke a scholarship based on an applicant's inappropriate behavior.
