- O **RSA 91-A:3,III(a)** - The dismissal, promotion or compensation of any public employee, or the disciplining of such employee or the investigation of any charges against him unless the employee affected (1) has a right to a meeting, and (2) requests that the meeting be open, in which case the request shall be granted.
- X **RSA 91-A:3,III(b)** - The hiring of any person as a public employee.
- O **RSA 91-A:3, III(c)** -Matters which, if discussed in public, would likely affect adversely the reputation of any person, other than a member of the body or agency itself, unless such person requests an open meeting. This exemption shall extend to an application for assistance or tax abatement or waiver fee, fine, or other levy, if based on inability to pay or poverty of the applicant.
- O **RSA 91-A:3, III(d)** - Consideration of the acquisition, sale or lease of real or personal property which, if discussed in public, would likely benefit a party or parties whose interests are adverse to those of the general community.
- O **RSA 91-A:3,III(e)** - Consideration or negotiation of pending claims or litigation which has been threatened in writing or filed against the body or agency or any subdivision thereof, or against any member thereof because of his or her membership in such public body until the claim or litigation has been fully adjudicated or otherwise settled. Any application filed for tax abatement, pursuant to law, with any body or board shall not constitute a threatened or filed litigation against any public body, board, or agency for the purposes of this subparagraph.
- O **RSA91-A:3,III(j)** –Consideration of confidential, commercial or financial information that is exempt from public disclosure under RSA91-A:5, IV in an adjudicative proceeding pursuant to RSA 541 or RSA 541-A.
