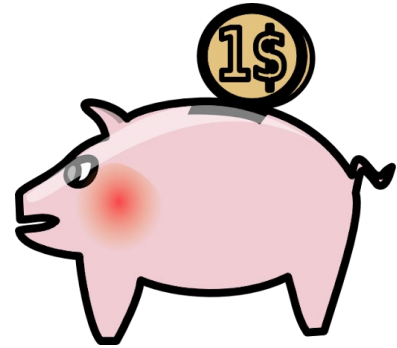

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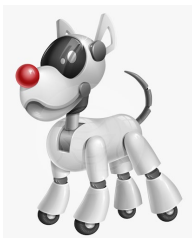

Summary: Students will learn basic and advanced sailing skills. Sailing takes place at the Bantam Lake Yacht Club. Each student must pass a basic swim test, given on the first day of practice. The test includes swimming 100 yards without a life jacket, treading water without a life jacket for 5 minutes and putting on a life jacket while in the water. Students are also required to purchase or rent their own life vest. Transportation **is not** provided
