# **Action Steps/Notes:**

- Teachers will meet on a monthly basis with the leadership team to review student data, engage in solutions-focused dialogue, and set goals for progress
- Strategies for differentiation at the various academic levels will be considered and implemented
- Any additional, relevant staff members/specialists will be invited to attend the data meetings
- Teachers will use performance data to inform small group instruction

Increase in development of individualized learning targets/goals as an outcome of data team meetings



1. Center School will take ownership of learning for all students through intentional data team and instructional practices that result in social, emotional, and academic growth for all learners.

### **Action Steps/Notes:**

- Ownership of learning for all students
- Adult support structure in classrooms Para/Special Education
- Professional development opportunities that focus on intended outcomes
- Continuous focus on Vision/Mission as a staff, individual/team/faculty
- Data team meeting structures that focus on the needs of all learners

# **Evidence of Success:**

Increase in development of individualized learning targets/goals as an outcome of data team meetings





1. East Hampton Middle School will design and implement differentiated instruction to meet the needs of all students while developing their progression within the Profile of a Graduate attributes as well as Academic Habits of Success.

# **Action Steps/Notes:**

- Learning targets developed by teachers and understood by learners
- Guaranteed Exit Slips to assess mastery of learning targets in order to inform instruction
- Student Centered Conferences will provide students the opportunity to showcase their growth on the Profile of the Graduate attributes and Academic Habits of Success

# **Evidence of Success:**

Teams and departments will utilize student work to analyze performance to monitor student progress





1. East Hampton High School will use multiple platforms to communicate and promote the new vision of East Hampton Public Schools.

### **Action Steps/Notes:**

- Each department will focus on one component of the East Hampton Public Schools Profile of the Graduate and develop 4 authentic learning experiences that meet the goals of East Hampton 2030
- Examine student achievement data through Professional Learning Communities (PLC Meetings) in order to improve student achievement

# **Evidence of Success:**

The departments and school will communicate individual learner progress toward achieving the school's Profile of the Graduate



2. The East Hampton Public Schools will...

- enhance K-12 education and activities in mathematics in order to ensure a strong foundation in STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics), leading to success in college and vibrant future careers.
- provide the necessary teacher support and training to effectively implement a dynamic mathematics education in all classrooms and schools.
- implement appropriate math intervention, acceleration, and enrichment to support the needs and development of all students.





2. All students at Memorial School will demonstrate growth in math across grade-specific domains by enhancing math workshop practices and toolkits in order to create differentiated math goals for every student.

### **Action Steps/Notes:**

- Classroom teachers will engage in instructional coaching cycles
- Staff will participate in targeted professional learning opportunities
- Grade level teams will develop common, diagnostic assessment measures
- Utilize the FAST block for targeted, small-group instruction

### **Evidence of Success:**

Improved math performance for all students





2. All Center School students will meet or exceed academic growth expectations in math by years end as determined by individual growth goals.

### **Action Steps/Notes:**

- Adopt school wide workshop model expectations
- Ongoing coaching cycles
- Mathematical practices as a building culture
- Revamping instructional minutes
- Vertical planning to support workshop instruction
- Incorporating FLEX as additional small group instruction
- Guaranteed access to district mathematical resources

# **Evidence of Success:**

Creation and adherence to coaching cycles Ongoing collection, documentation, and analysis of performance data





2. All East Hampton Middle School students will meet or exceed iReady targeted growth in Mathematics.

### **Action Steps/Notes:**

- Mathematics teachers will collaborate with the Math Specialist to improve and differentiate Tier 1 instruction
- Create/utilize common formative/summative assessments
- Math Instructional Specialist and Interventionists will provide a targeted approach to math intervention
- Provide enrichment opportunities to challenge learners
- Plan for application of math skills within Science and Technology Education

# **Evidence of Success:**

Monthly progress monitoring of data

Bimonthly department meetings

Ongoing analysis of student performance data on formative and summative assessments





# 2. East Hampton High School will demonstrate growth in math as well as all curricular and co-curricular areas.

### **Action Steps/Notes:**

- Teachers will analyze formative assessments to ensure appropriate differentiated and enrichment/instructional opportunities for learners
- Teachers will review and analyze relevant data in order to improve/promote the growth of *all* students resulting in *all* students improving

### **Evidence of Success:**

All students will improve in their skills and performance on standardized assessments in all areas including Math by the end of their high school career



# 3. The East Hampton Public Schools will...

- apply the knowledge, attitudes, and skills necessary to understand and manage emotions, set and achieve positive goals, feel and show empathy for others, establish and maintain positive relationships, and make responsible decisions. (Relationships)
- address gaps in learning and academic development with strategic intervention and targeted support, expecting that all children perform at or beyond grade level expectations as soon as possible. (Remediation)
- honor and celebrate the diversity of our students, our community, and our nation. We will guide our students to conscious, deliberate, individual and collective actions that cultivate the respect of all races, religions, and social backgrounds. And, we will produce graduates who are equipped with a greater understanding of the concepts of diversity, equity, and inclusion. (Relevance)





3. Memorial Elementary School will foster a positive culture where all members of the community feel valued and welcomed.

### **Action Steps/Notes:**

- Encourage language that welcomes all individuals and families
- Foster positive, respectful relationships among staff, students, and families through PBIS initiatives (school-wide behavioral expectations, celebrations and recognitions, communication with families)
- Diversify our classroom libraries
- Provide staff training around culturally responsive instruction
- Honor and celebrate the diversity of our community

### **Evidence of Success:**

Student and family survey: The percentage of families who respond to the question, "The diversity of our families and students is respected in the school" will increase from 76% to 85%





# 3. All Center School staff will implement a Positive Behavior Intervention System with fidelity to support the emotional well-being of all students.

# **Action Steps/Notes:**

- Revamp of school-wide behavioral expectations
- Build-in student ownership celebrations and recognitions
- Commitment to monthly school-wide celebrations connecting the Profile of the Graduate

# **Evidence of Success:**

Community and student survey feedback Student pre/post & reflective data SEL embedded skill development in core academic tasks





3. All East Hampton Middle School Staff and students will cultivate a positive culture by focusing on teacher-to-teacher, teacher-to-student, and student-to-student relationships.

### **Action Steps/Notes:**

- Continuing to implement the social-emotional curriculum Second Step utilized K 8
- Re-establish the PBIS committee in order to improve our PBIS program
- Provide team-building opportunities for both staff and students
- Facilitate partnerships with staff to support new teachers in the building

Utilizing the SEL Screener as mechanism to target tiered supports for students SWIS data for PBIS and tracking of PBIS tickets Community and student survey feedback
