#### 6. FINANCIAL REPORT

Mrs. Reisch, Business Manager, was unable to attend the meeting. Superintendent Lovato explained that due to the change in personnel at the end of January, financial statements are not completed yet. He recommended tabling the financial report. **FINANCIAL REPORT TABLED** 

#### 7. SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT AND RECOMMENDATIONS

Superintendent Lovato informed the Board that he, Mr. Canaday and Mrs. Haberman recently met with two architects from RTA Architects, LLC and discussed some ideas. Things are in the early stages and when the architects have plans, the committee will meet. Superintendent Lovato said several teachers participated in revising the meet and confer procedure at the Junior/Senior High School. Parent-teacher conferences are scheduled for February 22-23, 2018. Enrollment is up and the building is full. At the Intermediate School, several staff members attended the CCIRA conference. The Intermediate is implementing a new positive behavior program, as well as having a student/staff/parent climate survey be completed. Students, with the help of the counselor, are also utilizing the pulse check activity, which lets teachers know how they are feeling. The Primary School students have caught the reading bug! Students have been checking our many books from the library. Last week, students participated in the Be Drug Free Week. Recently, the Zoomobile came to the Primary and students enjoyed seeing different animals up close. The current enrollment is 343 students, compared to 319 last year. The Jump Start brochures have been updated for each building. Superintendent Lovato congratulated the state swimming qualifiers from La Junta Junior/Senior High School: Shawna Dieckmann and Madisyn Valdez. He also highlighted that Lisa Korbitz was named the 2018 Colorado High School State Championships 3A Swim Coach of the Year. La Junta has five wrestlers who qualified for the state wrestling tournament: Isaiah Gamez, Noah Barrett, Nick Martinez, Mitch Peabody, and Wyatt Buhr. Superintendent Lovato wished them luck. Director Ayala questioned the high number of officer referrals at the Intermediate School. Superintendent Lovato explained that Mrs. Westfall is diligent in reporting and documents every student contact she has. Director Leyba asked about the Jump Start parent letter. Superintendent Lovato clarified students cannot be punished for not taking the state assessments. He said the first day of school for all students is August 13, 2018, with Jump Start being a reward for students who do well on state assessments. He said if those students choose to come to school on August 13 instead of August 27, there will be something for them to do. If they choose to not attend early, they will have excused absences. Director Paolucci had a question on the revised Primary Jump Start brochure. Mrs. Haberman said will do some rewording to avoid any confusion.
