7. FINANCIAL REPORT

Merinda Reisch, Business Manager, explained the income for June was \$267,797.40 more than expenses. She said the auditor will be here September 4-7, 2018 and the business office is working on the year-end reports. Superintendent Lovato added he feels that after the audit the district will be in a very favorable position. **FINANCIAL REPORT APPROVED AS PRESENTED**

8. 2018 SUMMER FOOD SERVICE REVIEW

Mrs. Reisch reviewed the summer food service with the Board. She said the district incurred a \$1300.00 loss for the month of June. June 30 was the last day with Sodexo being the district food service provider. She said in June there were over 180 daily participants, which was lower than last year. This is in part to only having one location for serving meals, due to construction at the Primary. Chartwells began serving in July and there have been a couple of days that the number served reached 200.

9. 2018 COMMUNITY ELIGIBILITY PROVISION PROGRAM APPROVAL LETTER

The Community Eligibility Provision (CEP) Program approval letter was reviewed with the Board. CEP is an option for low income areas. Schools are reimbursed using a formula based on the percentage of students who are eligible for free or reduced meals. Mrs. Reisch explained that the district has risen almost four points, so the district will be receiving a higher refund back from the state. This year the district is at 89% students claiming free lunch status and last year the district was at 86%.

10. SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT AND RECOMMENDATIONS

Superintendent Lovato informed the Board that August 1 is the first day back for staff.

Superintendent Lovato recognized Mr. John Canaday for his hard and diligent work on the Primary Construction project. Mr. Canaday spoke to the Board. He said the modular units have been relocated to New Horizons. Mr. Canaday explained there were four construction companies who were pre-qualified to bid for the general contractor and their proposals were due last week. There was a bid opening and three of the four contractors were under the project budget. After adding project alternates to the bid, there was a \$1,000,000.00 difference between the low and high bidders. Mr. Canaday said H.E. Whitlock was selected and this company has completed several projects in La Junta. He said this company is familiar with the architectural firm in charge of the project. Mr. Canaday said there should be a signed contract hopefully by next week. Once the contract is signed, construction will begin. The project completion date is July 1, 2019.

Superintendent Lovato spoke about the WISH Grant. He said he is in the beginning stages of hiring a coordinator and the job description is available at Central Office.

This summer has been exceptionally busy with the construction project and the food service change.

Superintendent Lovato told the Board that he would like to re-purpose East Elementary School after the Primary moves back into their building. He does not want it to become a place for storage again.
