Mrs. Reisch, Business Manager, reviewed the fund balance with the Board. She stated expenses for the month totaled \$1,332,273.78 and income was \$2,149,317.26. She said spending has been capped, so upcoming expenses should be minimal. Maintenance will have some expenses due to summer clean up, but Mrs. Reisch said the major expenses should be done for the year. Director Paolucci inquired about the CPP (Colorado Pre-School Program) fund. Mrs. Reisch said we will be receiving revenues soon. Superintendent Lovato added the district is beginning to receive tax revenue, which is the reason for the increase in funds.
