## Community

Van Vleck Independent School District is a public school district based in the community of Van Vleck in unincorporated Matagorda County, Texas (USA). The district serves the communities of Van Vleck, Allenhurst, Caney, Cedar Lake, Cedar Lane, Hawkinsville, and Sargent. The district consists of Van Vleck High School, O.H. Herman Middle School, E. Rudd Intermediate School, and Van Vleck Elementary, utilizing a Pre-K thru 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup>- 5<sup>th</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup>, and 9<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> configuration.

#### **School**

Van Vleck High School is a comprehensive 4-year public high school enrolling 335 students in grades 9 through 12.

#### Curriculum

The academic program is organized on an 8-period class day. Each period is 47 minutes in length. AP courses are offered in Calculus, English 3 and 4, United States History, Environmental Science, Government, and Economics. Articulation agreements exist with local colleges and Texas Virtual School Network in order for students to enroll in college courses or take courses not offered on site.

# **Grade Point Average**

A student's Grade Point Average (GPA) includes all courses taken in grades 9-12. It is calculated on a 4-point scale with points being assigned as follows: A = 4.0, B = 3.0, C = 2.0.
