



ROYAL ISD COVID-19 SAFETY ALERT LEVELS

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LEVEL
1

PREVENTION (0-2% active case rate at district and/or campus level)

- Solid prevention measures in place
 - Masks optional
 - Health screenings for students and staff
 - Limited visitor access
 - Communicate to staff to stay home if sick
 - Frequently clean common areas
 - Ask parents to keep sick children at home
 - Communicate precautions needed to avoid spreading COVID
 - Consistent monitoring of community health trends
 - Notifications sent to parents and staff who were possibly exposed
 - Individuals in close contact will have the option to quarantine
 - Monitor attendance, communicate with local health authorities

MITIGATION (3 - 5% active case rate at district and/or campus level)

- All Level 1 responses
 - Masks are strongly recommended
 - Consider contingency plans and review district operations protocols
 - Potentially limit unnecessary travel
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LEVEL
3

MODIFIED OPERATIONS (6 - 8% active case rate at district and/or campus level)

- All level 1 and 2 responses
 - Consult with local health authorities regarding case spread; students and staff may be advised to self-quarantine
 - Limit the size of indoor and outdoor gatherings
 - Cohorting of students is recommended
 - Consider implementing mask mandate

HIGH ALERT (9 - 10% active case rate at district and/or campus level)

- All level 1, 2, and 3 responses
 - Ensure that all students have a school-issued device (Chromebook)
 - Consider cancelling all nonessential school events
 - Limit large gatherings to only essential events or consider postponing essential events
 - Consider canceling school events and building rentals
 - Consider cancelling travel
 - Host meetings virtually
 - Entire campus or facility and buses will receive deep disinfecting
 - District-wide communications to staff/parents with health monitoring guidance and potential next steps
 - Implement mask mandate

5

CLOSURES (11%+ active case rate at district and/or campus level)

- All level 1 - 4 responses
- Cancel all co-curricular and extra-curricular indoor and outdoor school events outside the normal school day
- Cancel all travel
- Deep disinfecting of all facilities and buses
- Consider closing campuses and/or entire district in consultation with Texas Education Agency and local health authorities
- In the event of campus closures, communicate to staff which staff members are to report to duty to maintain services
- Communicate to parents the extent of closures, estimated length of closures, and school/work accommodations (i.e., virtual learning)
