

My Child Has Tested Positive for COVID-19, What Do I Do?

Students who have been diagnosed with COVID-19, Regardless of Vaccination Status, Need to:

The COVID positive individual is required to isolate at home for 10 days from symptom onset -or- from the date of test collection if they were asymptomatic. They may return on day 11 only if they are fever free without the use of fever-reducing medications within the last 24 hours AND symptoms have begun to improve.

Steps for Parents/Guardians to Follow:

1. Keep your child home and contact the district's COVID-19 hotline to report the case by either calling 608-829-9018 or emailing COVID19@mcpasd.k12.wi.us
 - a. Attendance will be updated to reflect any future required absences from school (you do not need to separately contact your school's attendance line)
2. Work with teachers regarding a learning plan/missing work during the isolation period.
3. PHMDC will call parents/guardians of minors to investigate the case; work with them to help identify any close contacts.
 - a. PHMDC will contact anyone identified as a close contact
 - b. PHMDC will contact district Health Services staff if they need assistance in identifying close contacts.
