Standard	Guidelines
Implementation	This Alternative Methods of Instruction (AMI) will be implemented for the school closures and individual student quarantines throughout the school year associated with the coronavirus .
Planning/Plan Development	This AMI was developed with input from the staff at Smithton R-VI and will be evaluated on a regular basis and monitored by building administrators. It will be a blended style plan with a combination of virtual learning and print resources when necessary
Communication with Parents/Students	Communication with the family will occur at the beginning of each closure or quarantine and 2 way classroom communication will be ongoing throughout. The purpose will be communicated in student handbooks and will accompany this posted plan on the District website
Communication with Teachers and Certified Staff	Staff will be made aware of closure or quarantine through contact with building administrators as needed. Please don't hesitate to call our offices at school for any additional assistance.
Attendance	In order to consider a student in attendance for the day we need to be able to verify that assignments are received and completed. Students should turn in work completed during quarantine on the day they return. In the event of a closure, students should defer to individual classroom deadlines.
Students with Disabilities	Student work will follow along with a student's IEP or 504 Plan
Instruction/Materials/Resources	Families and teachers will need to work together and verify that they have received all assignments and/or resources. If families are unable to access materials and resources they should contact the teacher immediately
