To Parents, Guardians, and Patrons of Little Axe Public School,

Sometime during the evening/early morning of Wednesday April 25th/Thursday April 26th, 2018, someone cut the chain on the gate going into the north entrance of the elementary then entered into the Maintenance storage area by removing the gate. Once inside, they stole the Little Axe Public School 2005 Chevrolet Utility pickup which had maintenance tools, plumbing parts, and other miscellaneous items necessary for maintaining a school district (the keys were not in the vehicle). This is a vehicle which is used on a daily basis throughout campus. In addition to stealing the utility pickup, a 16 foot bumper pull flat-bed utility trailer was stolen along with a 2011, 4520 John Deere tractor with front end loader (with pallet forks) and box blade was stolen. The tractor was loaded onto the trailer. We believe that the Pickup, Trailer, and Tractor left the school and headed north on 168th Ave NE. The trailer had a flat tire on the right rear which was not aired up prior to leaving the school. If you have cameras that face 168 Ave. north of the school, we would appreciate information which could lead to getting the school property back.
