WHEN: Thursday, December 15th

- **Students should arrive at MMS between 7:30-7:45am.** Buses will be leaving Merritt at **8am sharp**. (Chaperones should also plan to arrive at this time.)
- Buses will return to MMS at approximately **4:00pm**. (If there is any significant change in time, Mrs. Runge will send an email to the 5th grade list.)

WHERE: Museum of the American Revolution, 101 S 3rd St, Philadelphia, PA 191062

WHAT TO BRING:

- Students and chaperones should pack a clearly labeled brown-bag disposable lunch and water bottle. (Our lunches will be collected upon our arrival at the museum and will be distributed to students in the lunchroom, after the museum tour.) There is NO food or drink allowed in the museum galleries.
- Students do NOT need to bring their backpacks to school that day.

WHAT TO WEAR:

• All 5th graders should wear their new, black & gold Cougar hoodies.

OTHER INFO:

- <u>Students may bring their phones</u>, but are NOT allowed to use them on the buses. They may only use their phone for taking pictures (no flash) at the museum. Chaperones will monitor proper phone usage.
- <u>Students may bring snacks</u> on the bus **please** be mindful of what kind of snack and how much your student brings. Remember that there can be **NO nut products** of any kind, due to allergies, and that students cannot share their snacks. Each student will be responsible for cleaning up his/her own trash on the bus.
- Students may bring a small amount of money for a visit to the museum gift shop at the end of the day, if time permits. (After lunch, chaperones should have about 20 minutes to bring their students to the gift shop and the rest room before boarding the buses to return to MMS.)
