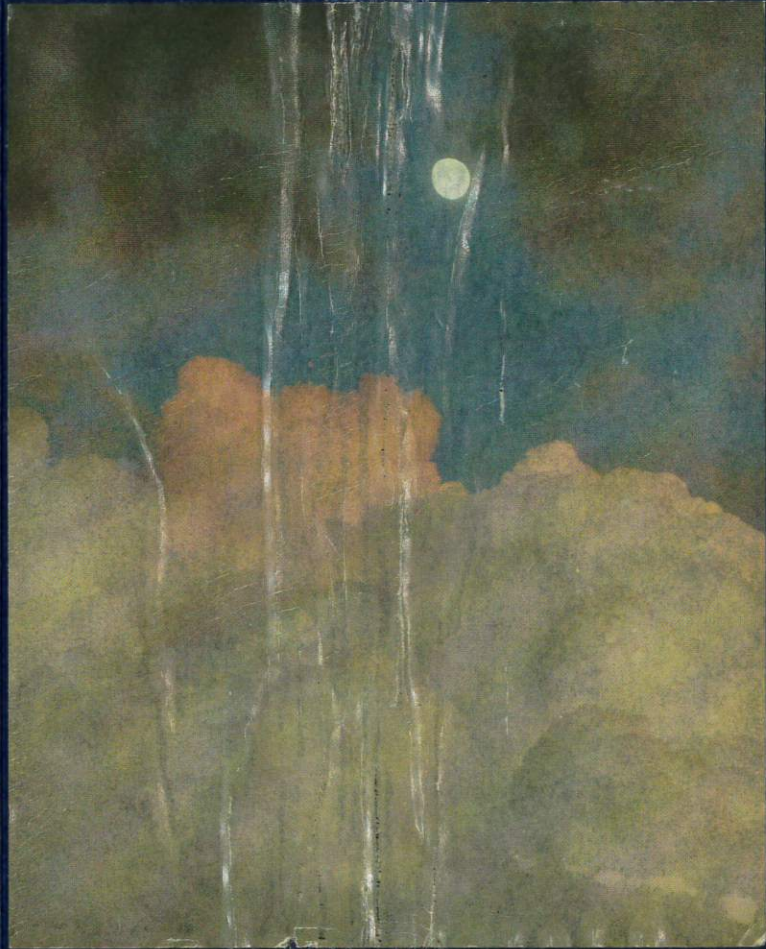

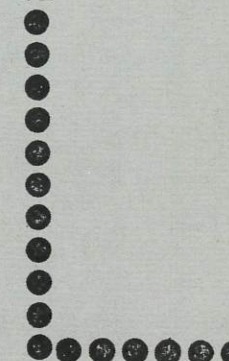


## IN MEMORY OF MICHAEL AFTEM

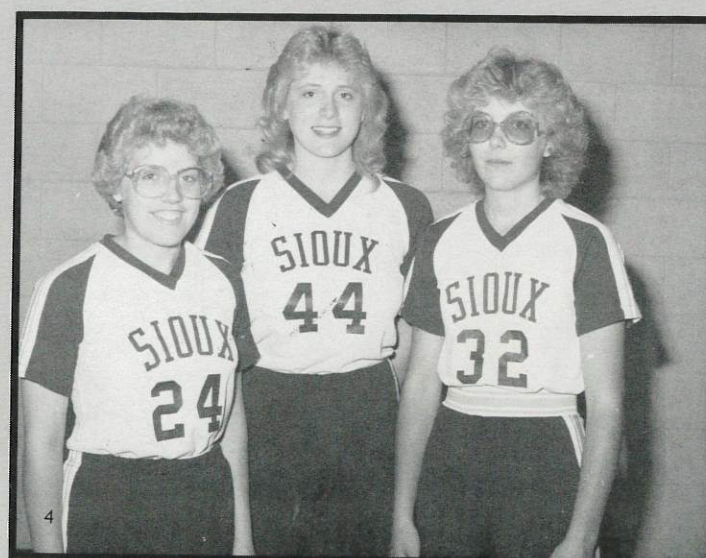


## GIRLS FALL SHORT OF REGION TITLE

Sabrina Huber-Sabrina ran off and got married. In case you want to write to her she lives in Mr. Roger's Neighborhood.

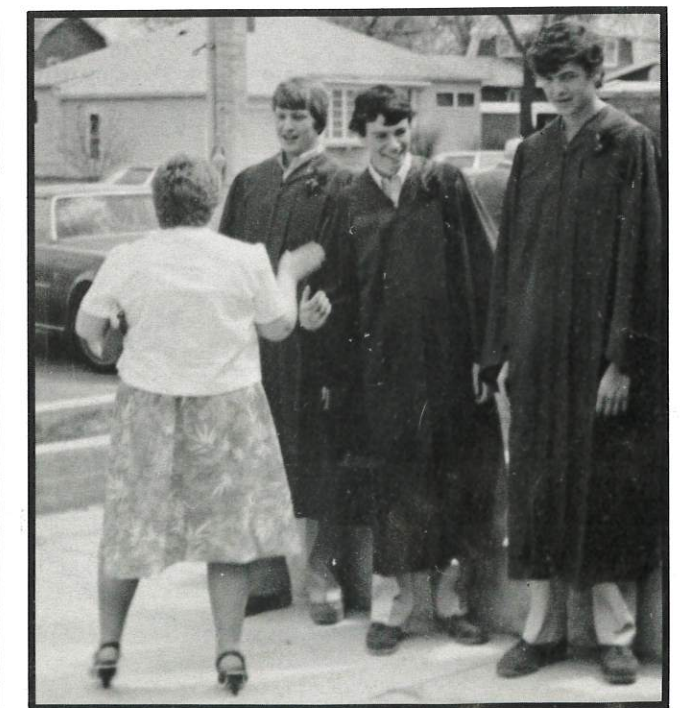
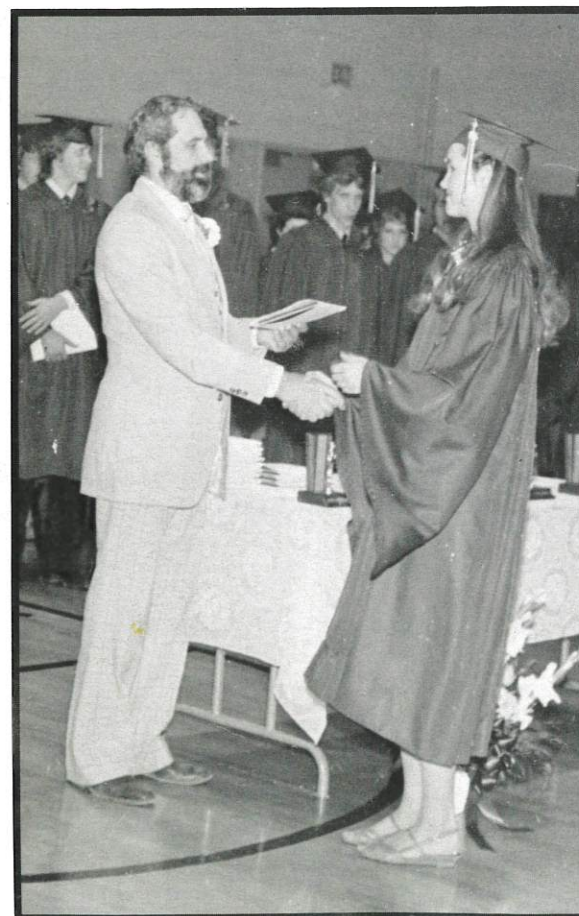
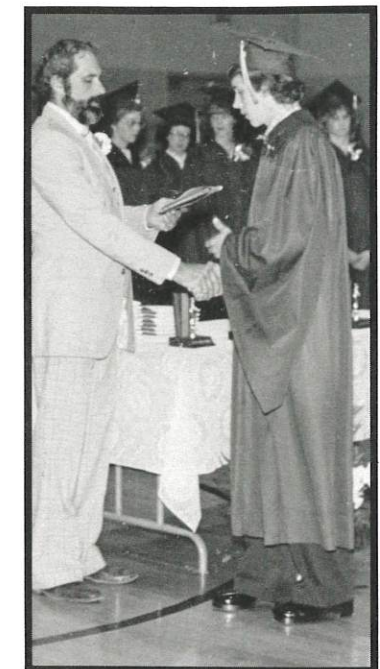
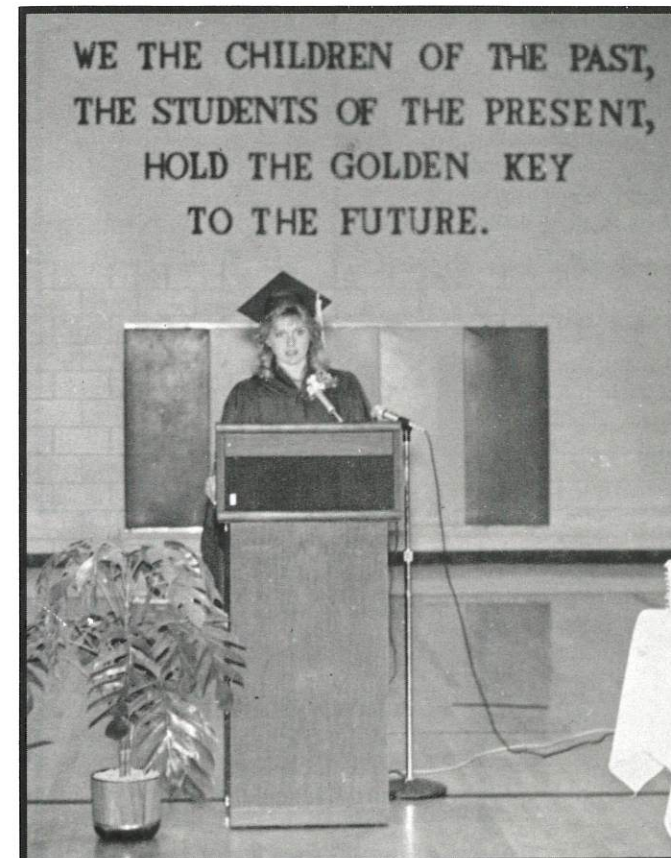
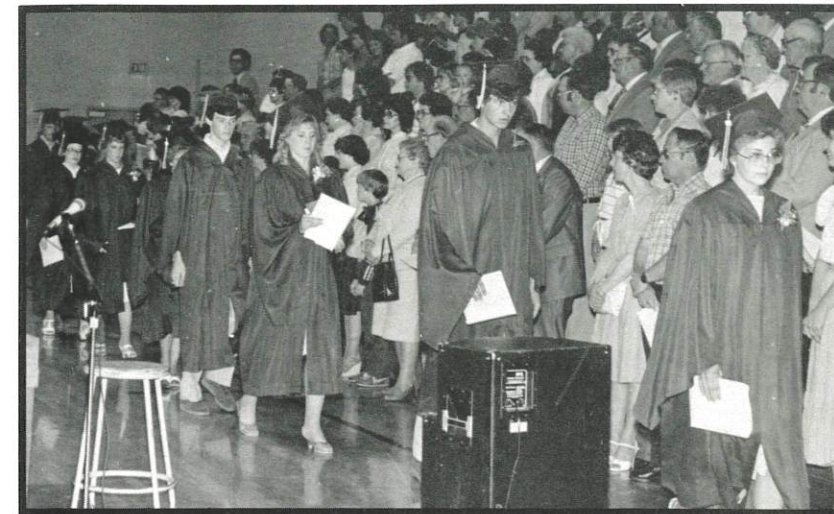
